## 1. Introduction

This manual provides detailed instructions for the proper use and care of your Casio G-Shock DW6900-1V Sport Watch. Designed for durability and functionality, this timepiece offers robust features for various activities. Please read this manual thoroughly to ensure optimal performance and longevity of your watch.

## 2. KEY FEATURES

The Casio G-Shock DW6900-1V is equipped with a range of features designed for reliability and utility:

- Shock Resistant: Engineered to withstand impacts and vibrations.
- 200 Meter Water Resistant: Suitable for swimming, snorkeling, and diving.
- EL Backlight with Afterglow: Provides illumination for easy reading in low light conditions.
- Flash Alert: Visual alerts accompany alarms, hourly time signals, and countdown timer time-up alarms.
- 1/100 Second Stopwatch: Measures elapsed time, split time, and 1st-2nd place times.
- Countdown Timer: Configurable timer for various activities.

- Multi-function Alarm: Set daily alarms.
- Hourly Time Signal: Chimes every hour on the hour.
- Full Auto-calendar: Automatically adjusts for different month lengths and leap years (up to year 2099).
- 12/24 Hour Formats: Choose between standard and military time displays.

# 3. INITIAL SETUP AND TIME ADJUSTMENT

Your watch comes with a pre-installed LR44 battery. Follow these steps to set the time and date.

#### 3.1 Button Functions

- ADJUST (Top Left): Used to enter and exit setting modes, and to confirm settings.
- MODE (Bottom Left): Cycles through the watch's various modes (Timekeeping, Stopwatch, Countdown Timer, Alarm).
- LIGHT (Bottom Center): Activates the EL backlight.
- START-STOP (Bottom Right): Used to start/stop stopwatch and countdown timer, and to change settings in setting modes.
- SPLIT-RESET (Top Right): Used for split times in stopwatch mode, and to reset values in setting modes.

# 3.2 Setting the Time and Date

1. In Timekeeping Mode, hold down the ADJUST button until the city code starts to flash. This indicates the setting

mode.

- 2. Press the **MODE** button to cycle through the settings: City Code → DST (Daylight Saving Time) → 12/24-hour format → Seconds → Hour → Minutes → Year → Month → Day.
- 3. Use the **START-STOP** button to increase the flashing value or the **SPLIT-RESET** button to decrease it (where applicable).
- 4. For seconds, pressing **SPLIT-RESET** will reset them to 00.
- 5. Once all settings are adjusted, press the ADJUST button to exit the setting mode.

### 4. OPERATING MODES

Press the MODE button to cycle through the watch's functions in the following order:

Timekeeping Mode → Stopwatch Mode → Countdown Timer Mode → Alarm Mode

## 4.1 Timekeeping Mode

This is the default mode, displaying the current time, day of the week, and date. Press the LIGHT button to illuminate the display.

#### 4.2 Stopwatch Mode

The stopwatch can measure up to 23 hours, 59 minutes, 59.99 seconds.

- 1. From Timekeeping Mode, press **MODE** once to enter Stopwatch Mode.
- 2. Press **START-STOP** to start the stopwatch.
- 3. Press START-STOP again to stop it.
- 4. Press SPLIT-RESET to reset the stopwatch to 00'00"00.
- 5. To record split times, press **SPLIT-RESET** while the stopwatch is running. The split time will be displayed for a few seconds, then the watch will return to elapsed time measurement.

#### 4.3 Countdown Timer Mode

The countdown timer can be set from 1 second up to 24 hours.

- 1. From Timekeeping Mode, press **MODE** twice to enter Countdown Timer Mode.
- 2. Hold down the ADJUST button until the current countdown time starts to flash.
- 3. Use the **MODE** button to select the hours or minutes setting.
- 4. Use the **START-STOP** button to increase the flashing value.
- 5. Press **ADJUST** to exit the setting mode.
- 6. Press **START-STOP** to start the countdown.
- 7. Press **START-STOP** again to pause/resume.
- 8. When the countdown reaches zero, an alarm will sound and the Flash Alert will activate. Press any button to stop the alarm.

#### 4.4 Alarm Mode

The watch features a multi-function alarm and an hourly time signal.

- 1. From Timekeeping Mode, press MODE three times to enter Alarm Mode.
- 2. Hold down the ADJUST button until the alarm time starts to flash.
- 3. Use the MODE button to select the hour or minute setting.
- 4. Use the **START-STOP** button to increase the flashing value.
- 5. Press **ADJUST** to exit the setting mode.
- 6. In Alarm Mode, press START-STOP to toggle the alarm (ALM) and hourly time signal (SIG) on or off. Indicators will

## 5. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

## 5.1 Cleaning Your Watch

Regular cleaning helps maintain the appearance and functionality of your watch. Wipe the watch case and band with a soft, dry cloth. For stubborn dirt, use a soft cloth dampened with water and a mild neutral detergent, then wipe dry. Avoid using volatile agents like thinner or benzine, as they may damage the resin components.

#### 5.2 Water Resistance

Your G-Shock DW6900-1V is rated for 200-meter water resistance. This means it is suitable for recreational scuba diving. However, avoid operating buttons underwater, as this can compromise the water seal. After exposure to saltwater, rinse the watch thoroughly with fresh water and dry it with a soft cloth.

## 5.3 Battery Replacement

The watch uses one LR44 battery (included). The battery life typically lasts for several years, but this can vary depending on usage of features like the backlight and alarm. When the display becomes dim or functions become erratic, it may be time for a battery replacement. It is recommended to have the battery replaced by an authorized Casio service center to ensure proper sealing and water resistance is maintained.

#### 6. Troubleshooting

If you encounter issues with your watch, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

- Blank Display or Dim Display: This usually indicates a low battery. Replace the battery as described in Section 5.3.
- Incorrect Time/Date: Re-adjust the time and date settings as described in Section 3.2. Ensure the correct city code and DST setting are selected.
- Buttons Not Responding: Ensure the watch is not in a mode that locks button operations. If the issue persists, a full reset might be necessary (consult a service center).
- Water Inside Display: If condensation or water droplets appear inside the watch, stop using it immediately and take
  it to an authorized service center. This indicates a breach in the water resistance.
