NTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the setup, operation, and maintenance of your Philips MCM 720 Micro Audio System. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the system to ensure proper functionality and to maximize your listening experience. Keep this manual for future reference.

SETUP

1. Unpacking

Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Ensure you have the main unit, two speakers, the remote control, and any included cables (power cord, speaker wires, FM antenna).

2. Speaker Connection

1. Identify the speaker terminals on the rear of the main unit and on each speaker.

- 2. Connect the speaker wires from the main unit to the corresponding terminals on the speakers. Ensure correct polarity (e.g., red to red, black to black) for optimal sound quality.
- 3. Position the speakers for the best stereo effect, typically equidistant from the listening position.

3. Antenna Connection (FM)

Connect the supplied FM antenna to the FM antenna terminal on the rear of the main unit. Extend the antenna fully and position it for optimal radio reception.

4. Power Connection

Plug the power cord into the AC IN socket on the main unit, then plug the other end into a wall power outlet.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Power On/Off

• Press the **ECO POWER** / **STANDBY-ON** button on the main unit or the power button on the remote control to turn the system on or off (standby mode).

2. Source Selection

Press the SOURCE button on the main unit or the corresponding source buttons (CD/USB, TUNER, TAPE,
 AUX) on the remote control to select your desired audio source.

3. CD/USB Playback

- 1. Press the **OPEN/CLOSE** button to open the CD tray. Place a CD (audio CD, MP3-CD, WMA-CD) with the label side up. Close the tray.
- 2. Alternatively, insert a USB device into the **USB DIRECT** port.
- 3. Select the CD/USB source. Playback should begin automatically.
- 4. Use the playback control buttons (PLAY/PAUSE, STOP, SKIP, SEARCH) on the main unit or remote.

5. Press SHUFFLE for random playback.

4. Radio Tuner Operation

- 1. Select the **TUNER** source.
- 2. Press the **TUNING** buttons (<< or >>) to manually tune to a station. Press and hold for automatic scanning.
- To store a preset: Tune to the desired station, press PROGRAM, then use ALBUM/PRESET buttons to select a preset number, and press PROGRAM again to confirm.
- 4. To recall a preset: Press **ALBUM/PRESET** buttons to cycle through stored stations.
- 5. The system supports **RDS** (Radio Data System) for displaying station information where available.

5. Volume Control

- Rotate the VOLUME knob on the main unit or use the VOL + / buttons on the remote control to adjust the sound level.
- Press the MUTE button on the remote to temporarily silence the audio. Press again to restore.

6. Sound Enhancements

- Press DSC (Digital Sound Control) to cycle through various equalizer presets (e.g., Jazz, Rock, Pop, Classic).
- Press **INCREDIBLE SURROUND** (or **DBB/IS** on remote) to activate or deactivate the Incredible Surround feature for an enhanced soundstage.

7. Timer and Sleep Functions

- Sleep Timer: Press the SLEEP button on the remote repeatedly to set a sleep timer (e.g., 15, 30, 60 minutes). The system will automatically turn off after the set time.
- Alarm Timer: Use the TIMER SET button on the main unit to configure an alarm to wake you up to a CD, USB, or radio source. Refer to the full manual for detailed timer setup instructions.

MAINTENANCE

1. Cleaning the Unit

- Disconnect the power cord before cleaning.
- Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the exterior surfaces of the main unit and speakers.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners, benzene, thinner, or alcohol, as these can damage the finish.

2. Disc Handling

- Handle discs by their edges to avoid fingerprints on the playing surface.
- · Store discs in their cases when not in use to prevent scratches and dust accumulation.
- If a disc is dirty, wipe it gently with a soft, lint-free cloth from the center outwards.

3. General Care

- Place the system on a stable, level surface.
- · Avoid exposing the unit to direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, high humidity, or dusty environments.
- Ensure adequate ventilation around the unit to prevent overheating.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Before contacting customer support, please refer to the following table for common issues and their solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No power	Power cord not securely connected.	Check if the power cord is firmly plugged into the unit and the wall outlet.
No sound	Volume is too low or muted. Speakers not connected correctly. Incorrect source selected.	Increase volume. Press MUTE on the remote. Check speaker wire connections. Select the correct audio source.
Disc not playing	Disc is dirty, scratched, or inserted incorrectly. Disc format not supported.	Clean the disc. Insert the disc with the label side up. Ensure the disc is an audio CD, MP3-CD, or WMA-CD.
Poor radio reception	FM antenna not properly positioned or connected. Interference from other electronic devices.	Adjust the position of the FM antenna. Move the system away from other electronic devices.
Remote control not working	Batteries are depleted or inserted incorrectly. Obstruction between remote and unit.	Replace batteries. Ensure correct polarity. Remove any obstructions. Point the remote directly at the unit's IR sensor.
