INTRODUCTION

This comprehensive kit features 638 durable metal and plastic parts, along with a robust 6-volt motor, allowing for the construction of 25 different motorized models. From cranes and helicopters to buggies and broadcasting vehicles, this set promotes critical thinking, problem-solving, and the development of essential STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics) skills through hands-on construction.

WHAT'S IN THE BOX

Your MECCANO Erector Super Construction Set includes:

- 638 assorted parts (metal plates, beams, gears, wheels, nuts, bolts, etc.)
- 1 x 6V electrical motor
- 1 x durable plastic carrying case with storage compartments
- 3 x real tools (wrenches, screwdrivers)
- 1 x instruction sheet (for 11 models, additional instructions for other models may be available online)

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Before beginning any construction, ensure all parts are accounted for by comparing them with the parts list in your instruction manual. The manual provides detailed graphical instructions for assembling various models.

Battery Installation and Motor Connection

The 6V electrical motor requires 4 AA batteries (not included). Follow the steps below to properly install batteries and connect the motor:

1. Open the battery case.
2. Insert 4 AA batteries, ensuring correct polarity (+/- alignment).
3. Close the battery case securely.
4. Connect the battery case to the motor as shown in the instructions.

General Assembly Tips

- Always refer to the instruction manual for step-by-step guidance for each specific model.
- Use the provided tools to securely fasten nuts and bolts. Avoid over-tightening.
- Pay close attention to the orientation of parts, especially gears and structural beams.
- For complex models, it can be helpful to work with an adult or another person.

BUILDING MODELS

This set allows you to build 25 different models, encouraging creativity and engineering exploration. The instruction manual provides detailed guides for several models, and additional instructions for other models can often be found on the MECCANO website.

Example Models

- Motorized Crane: A functional crane with a rotary body and extendable hook.

OPERATING YOUR MODELS

Once your model is fully assembled and the motor is connected, you can bring your creation to life. The motor provides functional motion to your models. Refer to the specific model instructions for details on how to activate and control its movements.

MAINTENANCE

- Keep all parts clean and dry. Wipe down metal parts with a dry cloth if they become dusty.
- Store all components in the provided carrying case to prevent loss and damage. The case features compartments for organized storage.
- Regularly check nuts and bolts for tightness, especially after extended play, and re-tighten as necessary.

- Remove batteries from the motor unit if the set will not be used for an extended period to prevent battery leakage.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Motor Not Functioning

- Ensure batteries are correctly installed and are not depleted. Replace with fresh batteries if needed.
- Verify all electrical connections between the battery case and the motor are secure.
- Check the motor's switch: Ensure it is fully engaged in the ON position (either forward or reverse). If the switch is left in an intermediate position, it may cause overheating and damage to the motor unit. Always ensure the switch is fully thrown to one side or completely in the center OFF position.
- Inspect gears for any obstructions or misalignment that might prevent movement.
