1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Mustang One-Piece Touring Seat 75464 is engineered to provide enhanced comfort for both rider and passenger during extended motorcycle touring. Its design focuses on delivering a supportive seating experience while maintaining a practical profile for rider foot placement.

Key Features:

- Designed for optimal rider and passenger comfort during long rides.
- Features a narrower seat nose compared to standard stock seats, facilitating easier ground reach for the rider.
- Constructed with a durable gel-coated 3/16-inch thick marine-grade fiberglass baseplate.
- Baseplate is designed to accommodate a Mustang or stock Harley driver backrest kit.

2. INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps for proper installation of your Mustang One-Piece Touring Seat 75464. Always ensure the motorcycle is stable and turned off before beginning any installation.

- 1. Preparation:** Ensure the motorcycle is parked on a stable, level surface with the engine off. Gather any necessary tools, such as wrenches or screwdrivers, that may be required for removing your existing seat and installing the new one.
- 2. Remove Existing Seat:** Locate and carefully remove the bolts or fasteners that secure your current motorcycle seat. Gently lift and remove the old seat from the motorcycle frame.
- 3. Inspect Mounting Area:** Clean the motorcycle's fender and frame area where the new seat will be mounted. Check for any debris, obstructions, or damage that could interfere with the new seat's fit.
- 4. Position New Seat:** Carefully place the Mustang One-Piece Touring Seat 75464 onto the motorcycle's frame. Align the seat's mounting tabs or slots with the corresponding attachment points on your motorcycle. Ensure the seat is seated flush against the frame.
- 5. Secure Seat:** Reinstall the bolts or fasteners to secure the new seat. Tighten all connections firmly, but avoid overtightening, which could damage the hardware or seat base.
- 6. Final Check:** After installation, gently tug on the seat in various directions to confirm it is securely attached and does not exhibit any movement or wobbling. Verify that all components are properly aligned and there are no gaps between the seat and the motorcycle frame.

3. CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Proper care and maintenance will extend the life and appearance of your Mustang Touring Seat.

- **Cleaning:** Use a mild soap and water solution with a soft, non-abrasive cloth to clean the seat surface. Gently wipe away dirt and grime. Avoid using harsh chemicals, solvents, or abrasive cleaners, as these can damage the seat material and stitching.
- **Drying:** After cleaning, allow the seat to air dry completely. Do not expose the seat to direct sunlight for prolonged periods while it is wet, as this can cause material degradation.
- **Protection:** To help prevent fading and cracking, especially if the motorcycle is frequently exposed to sunlight, consider applying a UV protectant specifically designed for motorcycle seat materials. Follow the product manufacturer's instructions for application.
- **Storage:** If storing your motorcycle for an extended period, it is recommended to cover the seat with a breathable cover to protect it from dust, dirt, moisture, and environmental elements.

4. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your touring seat.

- **Seat Does Not Fit Properly:**
 - Verify that the Mustang One-Piece Touring Seat model 75464 is indeed compatible with your specific motorcycle make, model, and year. Refer to the product's compatibility information provided at the point of purchase.
 - Ensure all mounting points on both the seat and the motorcycle frame are correctly aligned and free of any obstructions.
 - Inspect for any bent or damaged mounting hardware on either the seat or the motorcycle that might prevent a proper fit.
- **Discomfort During Rides:**
 - Allow a reasonable break-in period for the seat's foam and cover materials to conform to your body shape. This can take several rides.
 - Experiment with minor adjustments to your riding posture.
 - If the seat is designed to accommodate a backrest, consider adding one for additional lumbar

support, which can significantly improve comfort on long rides.

- **Squeaking or Movement After Installation:**

- Re-check all mounting bolts and fasteners to ensure they are securely tightened. Loose hardware is a common cause of movement or noise.
- Inspect for any foreign objects or debris that might be lodged between the seat base and the motorcycle frame, causing friction or improper seating.


