Setup Instructions

- Placement:** Place the humidifier on a firm, flat, water-resistant surface at least 2 feet away from the floor and 1 foot away from walls. Do not place on carpet or towels.
- Fill Water Tank:** Remove the frog-shaped mist lid and then lift the 1-gallon water tank from the base. Unscrew the cap at the bottom of the tank. Fill the tank with cool tap water. Do not use hot water.
- Secure Cap:** Screw the cap back onto the water tank tightly.
- Replace Tank:** Place the filled water tank back onto the humidifier base, ensuring it is seated correctly.
- Replace Mist Lid:** Place the frog-shaped mist lid back on top of the water tank.
- Connect Power:** Plug the power cord into a standard 120V electrical outlet.

Operating Instructions

- Power On:** Turn the control knob on the front of the humidifier clockwise to the "ON" position. The power indicator light will illuminate green.
- Adjust Mist Output:** Continue turning the control knob clockwise to increase the mist output. Turn counter-clockwise to decrease the mist output.
- Automatic Shutoff:** The humidifier will automatically shut off when the water tank is empty. The power indicator light will turn red.
- Power Off:** To turn off the humidifier, turn the control knob counter-clockwise until it clicks to the "OFF" position.

Maintenance

Regular cleaning is essential for optimal performance and to prevent mineral buildup and bacterial growth.

Daily Maintenance:

- Turn off the humidifier and unplug it from the outlet.
- Remove the mist lid and water tank.
- Empty any remaining water from the tank and base.
- Rinse the tank and base thoroughly with cool water.
- Allow all parts to air dry completely before reassembling or storing.

Weekly Maintenance (Disinfection):

- Follow daily maintenance steps.
- Fill the water tank with 2 tablespoons of white vinegar and 1 gallon of water. Let it sit for 20 minutes.
- Empty the tank and rinse thoroughly with clean water.
- Fill the base with 1 tablespoon of white vinegar and 1 cup of water. Let it sit for 20 minutes.
- Empty the base and rinse thoroughly with clean water.
- Wipe the nebulizer with a soft cloth or brush to remove any mineral deposits.
- Allow all parts to air dry completely before reassembling.

Troubleshooting

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No mist or low mist output.	Water tank empty. Mineral buildup on nebulizer. Humidifier not level.	Refill water tank. Clean nebulizer as per weekly maintenance. Place on a firm, flat surface.
White dust around humidifier.	Hard water used.	Use distilled or demineralized water. Clean regularly.
Unusual odor.	Stagnant water or dirty tank.	Empty and clean the water tank and base thoroughly.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Leaking water.	Water tank cap not secured. Tank not seated correctly. Unit placed on uneven surface.	Ensure tank cap is tightly screwed. Reseat the water tank firmly on the base. Place on a firm, flat surface.
