


Figure 1: Contents of the Logitech Cordless Desktop LX 710 Laser package, including the keyboard, mouse, USB receiver, and documentation.

SETUP

System Requirements

- PC with Windows XP or Windows Vista
- 1 available USB port
- CD-ROM drive

1. Install Batteries

Insert the provided AA alkaline batteries into the keyboard and mouse. Ensure correct polarity as indicated inside the battery compartments.

The keyboard typically requires 2 AA batteries, and the mouse typically requires 2 AA batteries.

2. Connect the USB Mini-Receiver

Plug the USB mini-receiver into an available USB port on your computer. The operating system should automatically detect the new hardware.

3. Install Software

Insert the provided CD into your computer's CD-ROM drive. Follow the on-screen instructions to install the Logitech software. This software enables customization of hot-keys and other advanced features.

After installation, restart your computer if prompted.

- Instant Access to Your Music: Powerful, side-mounted controls provide quick access to your favorite media applications, including Apple iTunes or Windows Media Player.
- One-Touch Communication: Manage your Internet communications with dedicated controls for launching email, messaging, or Internet call applications, and for adjusting volume.
- Windows Vista/XP Compatibility: Features a Start key and handy DocFlip controls for Windows Vista. These functions are also compatible with Windows XP.
- Premium Comfort: The integrated soft-touch palm rest provides comfort and support, designed to reduce fatigue during
 extended use.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning

- To clean the keyboard and mouse, use a soft, damp cloth.
- · Avoid using harsh chemicals, abrasive cleaners, or solvents, as these may damage the product's finish.
- Ensure no liquid enters the internal components.

Battery Replacement

When the keyboard or mouse performance degrades, it may be time to replace the batteries. Open the battery compartment on the underside of each device and replace the old batteries with new AA alkaline batteries, observing correct polarity.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Device Not Responding

- Check Batteries: Ensure batteries are correctly installed and have sufficient charge. Replace if necessary.
- Check USB Receiver: Verify that the USB mini-receiver is securely plugged into a working USB port on your computer. Try a different USB port.
- **Re-establish Connection:** Some cordless devices have a "Connect" or "Sync" button on both the receiver and the device. Press these buttons as per the quick-start guide to re-establish the connection.
- Interference: Move the keyboard and mouse closer to the USB receiver. Avoid placing the receiver near other electronic devices that might cause interference (e.g., cordless phones, Wi-Fi routers).

Software Issues

- Reinstall Software: If custom functions or hot-keys are not working, try uninstalling and then reinstalling the Logitech software from the provided CD.
- Check for Updates: Visit the Logitech support website for the latest software drivers and updates for your model.
