3. INSTALLATION

This extension tube is designed for straightforward installation using a slip joint connection. Ensure all necessary nuts and washers are present before beginning. Proper sealing is crucial to prevent leaks.

Installation Steps:

- Preparation:** Turn off the water supply to the sink or fixture where the extension tube will be installed. Clear the work area and have a bucket ready to catch any residual water.
- Disassembly (if replacing):** If replacing an existing tube, carefully loosen and remove the old component. Clean any debris from the connecting pipes.
- Positioning:** Place the new Keeney 1903K extension tube into position, aligning it with the existing drain components.
- Connect Slip Joint:** Slide the slip joint nut and washer onto the connecting pipe. Insert the extension tube into the pipe, ensuring the washer is properly seated.

- Test for Leaks:** Turn the water supply back on and check all connections for any signs of leakage. If leaks occur, gently tighten the nuts further or re-seat the washers.

- **Corrosion Check:** While chrome-plated brass is resistant to corrosion, inspect for any signs of wear or damage, particularly in areas with high moisture or chemical exposure.

Common Issues and Solutions:

- **Leak at Slip Joint Connection:**
 - Ensure the slip joint nut is adequately tightened.
 - Verify that the washer is correctly seated and not damaged. Replace if necessary.
 - Check for any burrs or imperfections on the pipe ends that might prevent a proper seal.
- **Slow Drainage:**
 - This is typically not caused by the extension tube itself unless it is obstructed. Inspect the entire drain system for clogs.
