# Hot Tools 1181 Professional 1-inch Spring Curling Iron User Manual

## IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

---

Please read all instructions carefully before using this appliance. Keep this manual for future reference.

- **WARNING:** Keep away from water and flammable materials.
- Avoid contact with skin to prevent burns. The curling iron barrel becomes extremely hot during use.
- Unplug the appliance immediately after use.
- Be cautious of the power cord to prevent tripping hazards.
- Do not use this appliance near bathtubs, showers, basins, or other vessels containing water.
- Do not immerse the appliance in water or any other liquid.
- Always ensure the appliance is completely cool before storing.

## PRODUCT OVERVIEW

---

The Hot Tools 1181 Professional 1-inch Spring Curling Iron is designed for creating long-lasting curls with consistent heat. It features a 24K Gold barrel for even heat distribution and Hot Tools' Patented Pulse Auto Heat Control, which senses heat loss and regenerates heat instantly.

## SETUP

1. Unpack the curling iron and remove all packaging materials.
2. Ensure the appliance is clean and free from any debris.
3. Place the curling iron on a heat-resistant surface, away from water and flammable objects.
4. Plug the power cord into a standard electrical outlet.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps for optimal curling results:

1. **Prepare Hair:** Ensure hair is clean, dry, and detangled. For best results and heat protection, apply a heat protectant spray before styling.
2. **Power On and Set Temperature:** Plug in the curling iron. Turn the temperature dial to the desired heat setting for your hair type. The iron can reach temperatures up to 430°F. Allow a few moments for the iron to heat up.

3. **Section Hair:** Divide your hair into manageable sections, typically 1-inch wide, depending on the desired curl size.
4. **Curl Hair:** Open the spring clamp, place a section of hair under the clamp, and wrap the hair around the 1-inch barrel. Hold the hair in place for approximately 5-10 seconds. The exact time may vary based on hair type and desired curl intensity.
5. **Release Curl:** Gently open the clamp and release the curled section of hair. Allow the curl to cool before styling further to help set the shape.
6. **Repeat:** Move on to the next section of hair and repeat the curling process until all desired sections are styled.
7. **Power Off and Unplug:** After styling, turn off the curling iron and unplug it from the electrical outlet.

## MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Ensure the curling iron is unplugged and completely cool before cleaning. Wipe the barrel and handle with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or immerse the appliance in water.
- **Storage:** Allow the curling iron to cool completely before storing. Store it in a safe, dry place, away from children and pets. Do not wrap the cord around the appliance, as this can damage the cord.
- **Cord Care:** Regularly inspect the power cord for any signs of damage. If the cord is damaged, discontinue use and contact customer support.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Appliance Not Heating:** Ensure the curling iron is properly plugged into a functioning electrical outlet and the power switch (if applicable) is turned on. Check for any tripped circuit breakers.
- **Inconsistent Heat:** The Hot Tools 1181 features Pulse Auto Heat Control to maintain consistent heat. If you experience significant inconsistencies, ensure the iron has fully heated up before use.
- **Hair Not Curling:** Ensure your hair is clean and dry. Adjust the temperature setting to a higher level if your hair is resistant to curling. Increase the holding time on the barrel.
- **Burning Smell:** Immediately unplug the appliance. A burning smell could indicate an electrical issue. Do not use the appliance and contact customer support.
