INTRODUCTION

SETUP

- 2. **Battery Installation:** The scale requires one 9V battery (included). Locate the battery compartment on the underside of the scale, open it, insert the battery with correct polarity, and close the compartment.
- 3. Placement: Place the scale on a flat, stable surface. Ensure the stainless steel weighing platform is securely in

place.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Power On/Off

- To turn the scale **ON**, press the **On/Off Tare** button.
- To turn the scale **OFF**, press and hold the **On/Off Tare** button for a few seconds. The scale also features an automatic shut-off after 10 minutes of inactivity to conserve battery life.

Changing Measurement Units

• To switch between kilograms/pounds (Kg/Lb) and grams/ounces, press the Kg/Lb button.

• When in ounces mode, you can toggle between fractional and decimal ounce display by pressing the Kg/Lb button again.

Tare Feature

The Tare feature allows you to reset the scale to zero, effectively subtracting the weight of a container or previously added ingredients. This is useful for measuring multiple ingredients in the same bowl.

- 1. Place an empty container on the weighing platform. The display will show its weight.
- 2. Press the On/Off Tare button. The display will reset to zero.
- 3. Add your first ingredient. The display will show its weight.
- 4. To add another ingredient, press the On/Off Tare button again to zero the scale, then add the next ingredient. Repeat as needed.

Volume Measurement (Cups & Tablespoons)

The Escali Pana V136 can measure ingredients in cups and tablespoons using its preprogrammed ingredient database. This feature provides accurate volume measurements based on the ingredient's density.

- 1. Place an empty container on the weighing platform and press the On/Off Tare button to zero the scale.
- 2. Press the Vol (Volume) button. The display will change to show "Cups tbs" and "0".
- 3. Refer to the laminated ingredient code list. Enter the 2-digit code for your desired ingredient using the numeric keypad.
- 4. Slowly add the ingredient to the container. The display will show the volume in cups and tablespoons. Stop when you reach the desired volume.
- 5. To measure another ingredient in volume, press the Clear button to reset the ingredient code and volume, then repeat steps 3 and 4.

MAINTENANCE

- Cleaning: The removable stainless steel platform can be washed with mild soap and water. The main body of the scale should be wiped clean with a damp cloth. Do not immerse the scale in water.
- Storage: Store the scale in a dry place away from extreme temperatures.
- Battery Replacement: Replace the 9V battery when the low battery indicator appears on the display.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Scale does not turn on.	Dead or improperly installed battery.	Check battery polarity or replace the 9V battery.
Inaccurate readings.	Scale not on a flat surface, overloaded, or dirty platform.	Ensure scale is on a stable, flat surface. Do not exceed 13lb capacity. Clean the weighing platform.
Display shows "Err".	Scale overloaded.	Remove items from the scale immediately. Do not exceed the maximum capacity.
