Disassembly for Cleaning

1. **Verify Unloaded:** Remove the magazine and visually inspect the chamber to confirm it is empty.
2. **Remove Slide Stop:** Follow the specific procedure for the CZ-52 to remove the slide stop.
3. **Separate Slide and Frame:** Carefully slide the barrel and slide assembly forward off the frame.
4. **Remove Recoil Spring and Barrel:** Disassemble these components from the slide as instructed.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

cleaning, lubrication, and storage practices.

Cleaning

- Use appropriate cleaning solvents and brushes for the bore, chamber, and other components.

Failure to Eject	Dirty chamber, worn extractor, weak recoil spring, underpowered ammunition.	Clean chamber, inspect/replace extractor, replace recoil spring, use appropriate ammunition.
Light Primer Strikes	Worn firing pin, dirty firing pin channel, weak hammer spring.	Inspect/replace firing pin, clean firing pin channel, replace hammer spring.
