1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the proper installation, operation, and maintenance of your Master Lock Model 770 Heavy-Duty Hidden Shackle Hasp. Designed for robust security, this hasp is ideal for securing trucks, trailers, vans, storefronts, and business gates. Please read these instructions carefully before installation and use to ensure optimal performance and security.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Master Lock Model 770 Hasp is constructed from solid steel, offering superior resistance against forcible attacks. Its design is specifically engineered to protect the shackle of a compatible hidden shackle padlock, preventing access by bolt cutters and other prying tools. 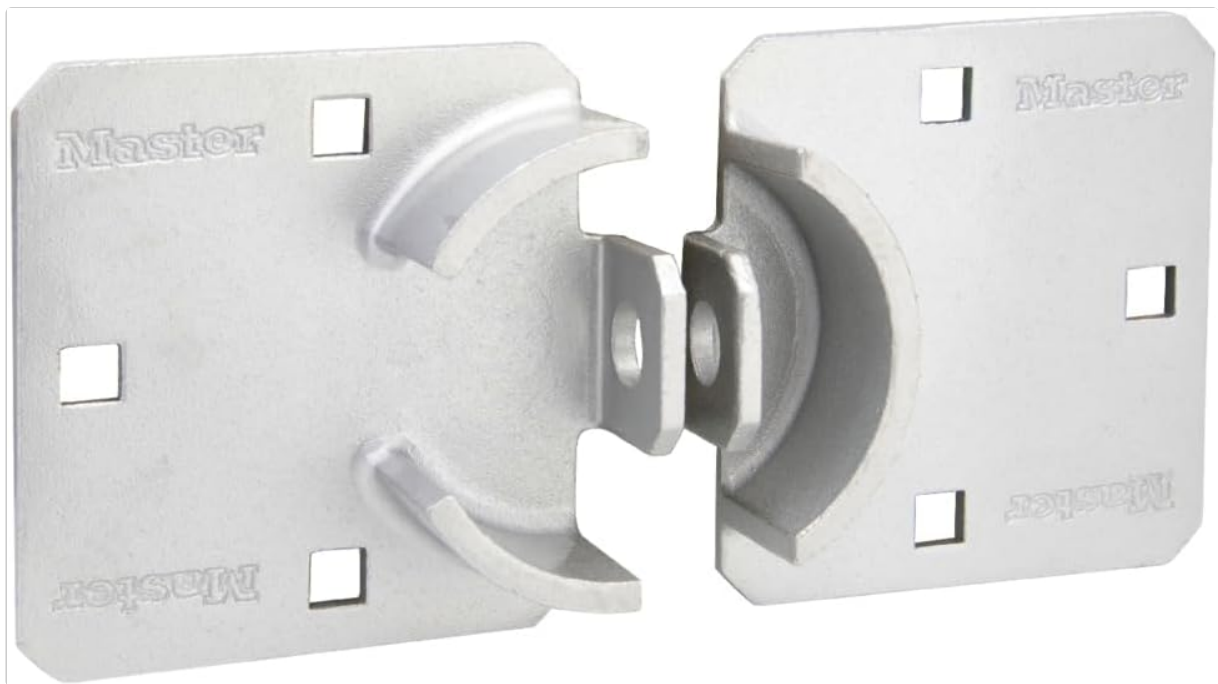

3. SAFETY INFORMATION

- Always wear appropriate safety gear, such as gloves and eye protection, during installation.
- Ensure the mounting surface is structurally sound and can support the hasp and resist forced entry attempts.
- Use appropriate fasteners (e.g., carriage bolts) that cannot be easily removed from the exterior.
- Keep hands and fingers clear of moving parts during installation and operation.

4. PACKAGE CONTENTS

- 1 x Master Lock Model 770 Hidden Shackle Hasp

Note: Compatible hidden shackle padlocks (e.g., Master Lock models 6270 and 6271) and mounting hardware (e.g., carriage bolts) are sold separately and are required for complete security.

5. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Proper installation is crucial for the security performance of the Master Lock Model 770 Hasp. This hasp is designed to be mounted with carriage bolts for maximum resistance against tampering.

Installation Steps:

1. **Prepare the Surface:** Identify the optimal location on your door, gate, or container where the hasp will be installed. Ensure the surfaces are clean, flat, and provide sufficient structural integrity.
2. **Position the Hasp:** Place the two halves of the hasp in their closed position on the desired mounting surface. Mark the locations for the mounting holes.
3. **Drill Pilot Holes:** Using an appropriate drill bit for your carriage bolts, drill pilot holes through the marked locations. Ensure the holes are straight and clean.
4. **Secure with Carriage Bolts:** Insert carriage bolts from the exterior side of the door/gate through the hasp and the drilled holes. Secure them with washers and nuts from the interior side. Tighten all fasteners securely.
5. **Test Alignment:** Once installed, ensure both halves of the hasp align correctly and can be easily closed and opened.

6. OPERATION

The Master Lock Model 770 Hasp is designed to be used with a compatible hidden shackle padlock (sold separately). The hasp's unique design completely encloses the padlock shackle, making it inaccessible to cutting tools.

Operating Instructions:

1. **Open the Hasp:** Ensure both halves of the hasp are in the open position.
2. **Close the Door/Gate:** Close the door, gate, or container you wish to secure.
3. **Engage the Hasp:** Bring the two halves of the hasp together so that the padlock receiving holes align.
4. **Insert Padlock:** Insert the shackle of your hidden shackle padlock through the aligned holes of the hasp.
5. **Lock the Padlock:** Engage the locking mechanism of your padlock. The hasp will now fully enclose the padlock, providing maximum security.
6. **Unlock and Open:** To open, unlock your padlock, remove it from the hasp, and then separate the hasp halves to open the door/gate.

7. MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and continued performance of your Master Lock Model 770 Hasp, follow these simple maintenance guidelines:

- **Regular Cleaning:** Periodically wipe down the hasp with a damp cloth to remove dirt and debris. For outdoor use, consider cleaning more frequently.
- **Lubrication:** While the hasp itself does not have moving parts requiring lubrication, ensure your

compatible padlock is regularly lubricated according to its manufacturer's instructions, especially in harsh environments.

- **Inspection:** Regularly inspect the hasp and its mounting hardware for any signs of wear, damage, or loosening. Tighten any loose bolts immediately. Replace the hasp if it shows significant damage that could compromise security.
- **Corrosion Protection:** The hasp is made of alloy steel with a zinc finish. For prolonged outdoor exposure, especially in corrosive environments, consider applying a rust-inhibiting spray periodically.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

Most issues with the Master Lock Model 770 Hasp are related to installation or compatibility.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Hasp halves do not align properly.	Incorrect installation; mounting surface uneven.	Re-check alignment during installation. Ensure mounting surface is flat. Adjust bolt tension.
Difficulty inserting padlock.	Misalignment of hasp holes; incompatible padlock.	Ensure hasp halves are fully engaged and aligned. Verify padlock is a hidden shackle type and fits the opening.
Hasp appears loose after installation.	Mounting bolts are not sufficiently tightened.	Tighten all carriage bolts securely. Consider using lock washers if vibration is an issue.
