5. Setup and Installation

The Taylor Made Fender Lock and Peg Set is designed for straightforward installation. Follow these steps for secure mounting:

- Choose Location:** Select a suitable, flat surface on your boat's gunwale or desired mounting area. Ensure the location provides adequate clearance for fender lines and does not interfere with other boat operations.
- Mark Drilling Points:** Place the fender lock in the chosen position and use a pencil or marker to accurately mark the two screw holes.
- Drill Pilot Holes:** Using an appropriate drill bit size for the included mounting screws, carefully drill pilot holes at the marked locations. Ensure not to drill too deep.
- Secure Fender Lock:** Align the fender lock with the pilot holes and secure it firmly using the provided stainless steel mounting screws. Use a screwdriver or drill with appropriate bit, ensuring a snug fit without overtightening.
- Attach Fender Peg:** The fender peg is designed to be attached to your fender line. Thread your fender rope through the hole in the fender peg and secure it with a knot. The peg should be positioned on the rope so that when inserted into the fender lock, the fender hangs at the desired height.

Important: Ensure the mounting surface is strong enough to support the weight and tension of the fender, especially in choppy waters. For optimal security, consider using marine-grade sealant around the screw holes to prevent water intrusion.

6. Operating Instructions

Using your Taylor Made Fender Lock and Peg Set is simple and efficient:

- Insert Peg:** With the fender attached to the fender peg, simply insert the peg into the opening of the mounted fender lock.
- Secure Position:** The design of the lock and peg allows the fender to hang securely. Gravity and the weight of the fender will help keep the peg in place.
- Adjust Height (if needed):** If the fender height needs adjustment, remove the peg from the lock, re-tie the knot on the fender rope to reposition the peg, and re-insert.
- Remove Fender:** To remove the fender, simply lift the fender peg out of the fender lock. This allows for quick deployment and retrieval of fenders.

7. Care and Maintenance

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your stainless steel fender lock and peg set, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- **Regular Cleaning:** Periodically clean the stainless steel components with fresh water and a mild soap solution. Rinse thoroughly to remove any salt residue or dirt.
- **Inspect for Wear:** Regularly inspect the fender lock, peg, and mounting screws for any signs of wear, corrosion, or damage.
- **Tighten Fasteners:** Check mounting screws periodically and tighten if necessary to ensure the lock remains securely fastened to your boat.
- **Avoid Harsh Chemicals:** Do not use abrasive cleaners, steel wool, or harsh chemicals, as these can damage the stainless steel finish.

8. Troubleshooting

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Fender lock feels loose after installation.	Mounting screws are not fully tightened or have come loose.	Tighten all mounting screws. If the holes are stripped, consider relocating the lock or using larger screws/anchors suitable for marine use.
Fender peg does not sit securely in the lock.	Incorrect rope size or improper knotting of the fender peg.	Ensure your rope diameter is within the specified 1/2 inch limit. Re-tie the knot on the fender peg to ensure it's snug and allows the peg to sit correctly.
Signs of rust or discoloration on stainless steel.	Exposure to harsh marine environment without regular cleaning; surface contamination.	Clean with fresh water and mild soap. For stubborn spots, use a stainless steel cleaner designed for marine applications. Regular rinsing after saltwater exposure is crucial.
