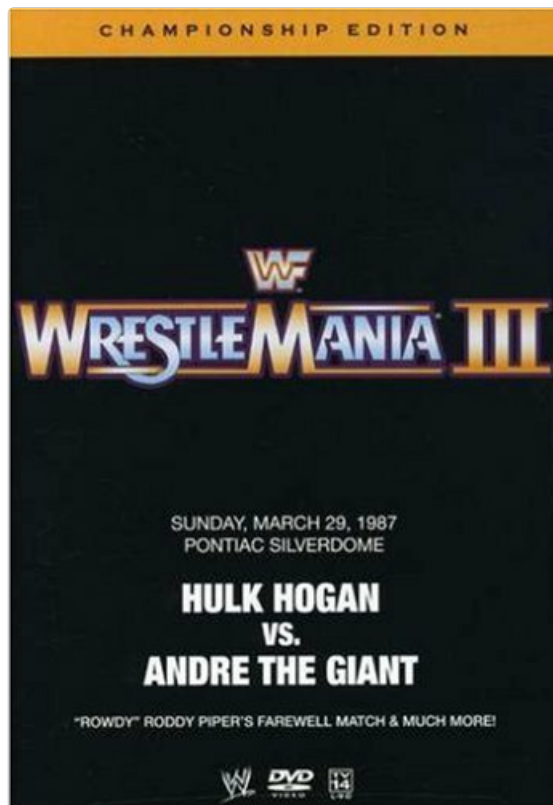

2. SETUP AND PLAYBACK

To begin watching your WWE WrestleMania III Championship Edition DVD, follow these steps:

- **Cleaning:** If the disc becomes dirty, gently wipe the playing surface with a soft, lint-free cloth in a straight line from the center to the outer edge. Do not use abrasive materials or circular motions.
- **Storage:** Store the DVD in its original case, away from direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, and high humidity.
- **Avoid Scratches:** Prevent scratches by keeping the disc in its case when not in use and away from sharp objects.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

| Issue | Possible Solution |
|-------------------------------|---|
| Disc does not play or load. | Ensure the disc is inserted correctly (label side up). Clean the disc surface for smudges or dust. Check if your DVD player is compatible with DVD format. Try playing the disc in another DVD player or computer. |
| Video or audio skips/freezes. | Clean the disc surface carefully. Check for visible scratches or damage on the disc. Ensure your DVD player's lens is clean (refer to your player's manual for cleaning instructions). |
| No sound. | Check the volume level on your TV and DVD player. Ensure audio cables are securely connected. Verify that the correct audio track is selected in the DVD menu (if applicable). |
