1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides instructions for the setup, operation, and maintenance of your HP iPAQ Bluetooth Foldable Keyboard (Model FA802AA). This keyboard is designed to enhance productivity by offering a full-sized typing experience for your HP iPAQ device, allowing for efficient data entry and email composition while on the go.

2. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all items are present in the package:

- HP iPAQ Bluetooth Foldable Keyboard
- USB Cable (for charging)
- User Manual (this document)

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The HP iPAQ Bluetooth Foldable Keyboard features an ergonomic, QWERTY layout with 105 keys. Its foldable design allows for compact storage and portability. The keyboard connects wirelessly via Bluetooth technology.

Key Features:

- **Foldable Design:** For easy transport and storage.
- **Bluetooth Connectivity:** Wireless connection to compatible devices.

4. SETUP

4.1 Charging the Keyboard

1. Connect the supplied USB cable to the keyboard's charging port.
2. Connect the other end of the USB cable to a powered USB port (e.g., computer, USB wall adapter).
3. Allow the keyboard to charge fully before first use. The charging indicator light (if present) will change color or turn off when charging is complete.

4.2 Pairing with Your Device

To pair the keyboard with your HP iPAQ or other compatible device:

1. Ensure the keyboard is charged and powered on.
2. Activate Bluetooth on your HP iPAQ device. Refer to your iPAQ's user manual for specific instructions on enabling Bluetooth.
3. Put the keyboard into pairing mode. This usually involves pressing a dedicated Bluetooth pairing button or a combination of keys (refer to the keyboard's physical markings for specific instructions, if any). A status light may flash to indicate pairing mode.
4. On your iPAQ, search for available Bluetooth devices. The keyboard should appear in the list, typically as "HP iPAQ Keyboard" or a similar name.

5. Select the keyboard from the list and follow any on-screen prompts to complete the pairing process. You may be required to enter a passkey displayed on your iPAQ into the keyboard.
6. Once paired, the keyboard's status light will indicate a successful connection, and you can begin using it.

5. OPERATING THE KEYBOARD

5.1 Opening and Positioning

1. Carefully unfold the keyboard until it lies flat and locks into position.
2. Position your HP iPAQ device in a comfortable viewing angle. The keyboard may include a built-in stand for this purpose.

5.2 Using Shortcut Keys

The keyboard includes several shortcut keys designed for quick access to common functions on your HP iPAQ. These keys are typically marked with icons or specific functions. Refer to the keyboard's keycap legends for their specific actions.

- **Function (Fn) Key:** Often used in combination with other keys to access secondary functions (e.g., volume control, brightness adjustment).
- **Application Launch Keys:** Dedicated keys for launching specific applications like email, calendar, or web browser.

Note: The functionality of some shortcut keys may depend on the operating system version of your connected device.

6. MAINTENANCE

6.1 Cleaning

- Ensure the keyboard is powered off before cleaning.
- Use a soft, lint-free cloth slightly dampened with water or a mild cleaning solution to wipe the surface of the keyboard.
- Do not use harsh chemicals, abrasive cleaners, or spray liquids directly onto the keyboard.
- Use compressed air to remove debris from between the keys.

6.2 Storage

When not in use, fold the keyboard into its compact form and store it in a dry, cool place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

7.1 Keyboard Not Connecting

- **Check Power:** Ensure the keyboard is charged and powered on.
- **Bluetooth On:** Verify that Bluetooth is enabled on your HP iPAQ device.
- **Re-pair Device:** If the keyboard was previously paired, try unpairing it from your device's Bluetooth settings and then re-pairing it following the instructions in Section 4.2.
- **Distance:** Ensure the keyboard is within the effective range of your Bluetooth device (typically up to 10 meters or 33 feet).

- **Interference:** Move away from other wireless devices that might cause interference.

7.2 Keys Not Responding

- **Connection:** Confirm the keyboard is properly connected via Bluetooth.
- **Battery:** The keyboard battery may be low. Charge the keyboard.
- **Restart:** Try restarting both the keyboard (if possible) and your HP iPAQ device.
