1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Jetboil Jetpower 4-Season Fuel Blend is formulated for maximum efficiency and minimal consumption, designed to power Jetboil's range of backcountry camping stoves. This 100-gram canister provides high vapor pressure, ensuring optimal system performance even in cold weather conditions. The propane/isobutane blend offers consistent pressure as the fuel level decreases, making it reliable for all seasons.

- **High-Performance Blend:** Propane/isobutane mix for consistent performance in various temperatures.
- **Efficiency:** 100 grams of fuel can boil approximately 12 liters of water.
- **Compact Design:** Minimal pack space at 3.5 by 2.8 inches (9 cm x 7 cm) and weighs only 7.02 ounces.
- **Compatibility:** Works with Jetboil Flash, Joule, MicroMo, MightyMo, SUMO, and Zip camping stoves.
- **Recyclable:** Easily recyclable with the optional Jetboil CrunchIt tool.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Always prioritize safety when handling pressurized fuel. Read and understand all warnings and instructions provided on the canister and with your Jetboil stove system before use.

- **Ventilation:** Use in well-ventilated areas only. Avoid enclosed spaces to prevent carbon monoxide buildup.
- **Ignition Sources:** Keep away from open flames, sparks, and other ignition sources.
- **Storage:** Store in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and temperatures exceeding 120°F (49°C).
- **Handling:** Do not puncture, incinerate, or expose to extreme heat. Do not refill non-refillable canisters.
- **Leak Check:** Always check for leaks after attaching the fuel canister to your stove.
- **Children and Pets:** Keep out of reach of children and pets.

3. SETUP

Proper setup ensures safe and efficient operation of your Jetboil system.

1. **Prepare Your Stove:** Ensure your Jetboil compatible stove (e.g., Flash, Joule, MicroMo, MightyMo, SUMO, Zip) is clean and in good working order.
2. **Attach Fuel Canister:** Align the threaded valve of the Jetpower fuel canister with the stove's fuel connector. Screw the canister onto the stove firmly by hand until snug. Do not overtighten.
3. **Stabilize (if applicable):** If your stove system includes a fuel canister stabilizer, attach it to the base of the fuel canister for increased stability on uneven surfaces.
4. **Leak Check:** After attaching, listen for any hissing sounds or apply a small amount of soapy water to the connection point. Bubbles indicate a leak. If a leak is detected, tighten the connection or replace the canister if necessary.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once the fuel canister is securely attached and checked for leaks, you can begin operating your stove.

1. **Open Fuel Valve:** Slowly turn the fuel valve on your stove counter-clockwise to allow gas to flow. You

should hear a faint hissing sound.

2. **Ignite Flame:** Use the integrated igniter button on your Jetboil stove (if available) or an external lighter/match to ignite the gas. The flame should appear immediately.
3. **Adjust Flame:** Use the fuel valve to adjust the flame intensity. Turn clockwise to decrease the flame and counter-clockwise to increase it.
4. **Cooking:** Place your cooking pot or vessel onto the stove's pot support. Monitor your cooking and adjust the flame as needed.
5. **Shut Down:** When finished cooking, turn the fuel valve clockwise until the flame extinguishes completely. Allow the stove and pot to cool down before handling.

5. MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and safe operation of your fuel canister and stove system.

- **Cleaning:** Keep the fuel canister and stove connector clean and free from debris.
- **Inspection:** Regularly inspect the canister for any signs of damage, dents, or corrosion. Do not use a damaged canister.
- **Recycling:** Jetpower canisters are easily recyclable. Use a Jetboil CrunchIt tool (sold separately) to safely puncture and prepare empty canisters for recycling. The CrunchIt tool clips onto a carabiner or key ring for convenience.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Jetboil Jetpower fuel or stove, consider the following:

- **No Flame/Weak Flame:**
 - Check if the fuel canister is empty.
 - Ensure the canister is securely attached and the valve is fully open.
 - Verify the igniter is functioning. If not, use an external flame source.
 - In very cold conditions, warm the canister slightly (e.g., in a pocket) to increase vapor pressure.

- **Gas Leak:**

- Immediately turn off the fuel valve.
- Tighten the canister connection. If the leak persists, disconnect the canister in a well-ventilated area and replace it.

- **Stove Not Heating Efficiently:**

- Ensure the flame is blue and stable. Yellow or flickering flames may indicate incomplete combustion or a low fuel level.
- Check for wind interference; use a windscreen if necessary (ensure proper ventilation).
