SETUP

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your DVD, follow these care guidelines:

- **Handling:** Always hold the DVD by its outer edges or the center hole. Avoid touching the shiny playback surface.
- **Cleaning:** If the disc becomes dirty, gently wipe it with a soft, lint-free cloth (like a microfiber cloth) from the center outwards. Do not use abrasive materials or harsh cleaning chemicals.
- **Storage:** Store the DVD in its original case, away from direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, and high humidity.
- **Avoid Scratches:** Do not bend the disc or place it on rough surfaces. Scratches can lead to playback errors.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Disc not playing / "No Disc" error	Disc inserted incorrectly, dirty disc, or player issue.	Ensure disc is inserted label-side up. Clean the disc. Try another DVD to confirm player functionality.
Skipping or freezing playback	Scratched or dirty disc.	Clean the disc carefully. Inspect for deep scratches.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No audio	Incorrect audio track selected, TV/player volume low, or audio cables disconnected.	Check DVD audio settings. Increase volume. Verify audio cable connections.
No subtitles	Subtitles not enabled or incorrect language selected.	Enable subtitles from the DVD menu and select the desired language.
