# TW Steel Goliath TW118W Chronograph Watch User Manual

Model: TW118W

## INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the **TW Steel Goliath TW118W Chronograph Watch**. This manual provides essential information for the proper setup, operation, and maintenance of your timepiece. Please read it thoroughly to ensure optimal performance and longevity of your watch.

The TW Steel Goliath TW118W features a robust stainless steel case, a stylish white leather strap, and a precise quartz chronograph movement. Its elegant design is complemented by a fixed silver-tone bezel set with diamonds, a white dial with clear Arabic numeral hour markers, and functional sub-dials for chronograph measurements.

## SETUP

---

Before using your watch, familiarize yourself with its components:

- **Crown (B):** Used for setting time and date.
- **Pusher A:** Used to start/stop the chronograph.
- **Pusher C:** Used to reset the chronograph.

## Setting the Time

1. Pull the crown (B) out to position 2. The second hand will stop.
2. Turn the crown (B) clockwise or counter-clockwise to set the hour and minute hands.
3. Push the crown (B) back to position 0 (normal position). The second hand will resume movement.

## Setting the Date

1. Pull the crown (B) out to position 1.
2. Turn the crown (B) counter-clockwise to set the date.
3. Push the crown (B) back to position 0 (normal position).

*Note: Avoid setting the date between 9:00 PM and 3:00 AM, as this may interfere with the automatic date change mechanism.*

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### Chronograph Function

Your TW Steel Goliath TW118W watch is equipped with a chronograph function, allowing you to measure elapsed time. The three sub-dials display 60 minutes, 60 seconds, and 24 hours.

- **Start/Stop:** Press pusher A to start the chronograph. Press pusher A again to stop it.
- **Reset:** While the chronograph is stopped, press pusher C to reset all chronograph hands to their zero positions.

## MAINTENANCE

### Cleaning

Regularly clean your watch with a soft, dry cloth. For the leather strap, avoid excessive moisture and harsh chemicals. If the strap becomes dirty, gently wipe it with a slightly damp cloth and allow it to air dry completely before wearing.

### Water Resistance

This watch is water resistant up to **100 meters (330 feet)**. It is suitable for showering, swimming, and snorkeling, but not for diving. Always ensure the crown is fully pushed in before any contact with water to

maintain water resistance.

## Battery Replacement

The watch is powered by a quartz movement and requires a battery. When the battery is low, the second hand may jump in two-second intervals as an End-of-Life (EOL) indicator. Battery replacement should be performed by a qualified watch technician to avoid damage to the movement or case and to ensure water resistance is maintained.

## Strap Care

The white leather strap is durable but can be affected by sweat, moisture, direct sunlight, and cosmetics. To prolong its life, avoid prolonged exposure to extreme temperatures and direct sunlight. If the strap gets wet, dry it thoroughly with a soft cloth and allow it to air dry naturally.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Watch not running	Battery depleted	Replace battery (professional service recommended).
Hands not moving smoothly or irregularly	Impact or strong magnetic field exposure	Consult a professional watch repair service.
Date not changing at midnight	Time set incorrectly (AM/PM cycle)	Advance the time by 12 hours.
Chronograph hands not resetting to zero	Requires calibration	Consult a professional watch repair service for adjustment.
