INTRODUCTION



OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS


The Kent SPC84 Hair Pick Comb is designed for various styling needs, particularly for curly and thick hair.

General Combing and Detangling:

1. Hold the comb with a comfortable grip.
2. Begin combing from the ends of your hair, working your way up to the roots. This helps to gently detangle without causing breakage.
3. For stubborn tangles, use short, gentle strokes.

Adding Volume and Lift (Using the Prong Fork):

1. Section your hair as desired.
2. Insert the prongs of the comb close to the scalp, underneath the section of hair you wish to lift.
3. Gently lift the comb upwards and away from the scalp to create volume.
4. For backcombing, insert the prongs into a section of hair and push downwards towards the scalp in short, controlled motions.
5. Repeat as necessary to achieve the desired volume and shape.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

- **Cleaning:** Regularly remove loose hair from the comb. Wash with mild soap and lukewarm water as needed. Rinse thoroughly and air dry.
- **Storage:** Store the comb in a clean, dry place away from direct sunlight or extreme temperatures.
- **Inspection:** Periodically check the comb for any signs of wear, such as bent or broken teeth. While durable, proper care extends its lifespan.

TROUBLESHOOTING

| Problem | Possible Cause | Solution |
|-----------------------------|---|---|
| Comb causes static in hair. | Extremely dry hair or environment. | Ensure hair is adequately moisturized. The comb is antistatic, but severe dryness can still cause some static. Consider using a leave-in conditioner. |
| Prong breaks during use. | Excessive force applied, or comb used on severely tangled hair. | Always detangle gently, starting from ends. Avoid forcing the comb through knots. If a prong breaks, discontinue use to prevent hair damage. |
| Comb feels rough on scalp. | Improper technique or sensitive scalp. | Ensure you are using the comb with light pressure. The rounded teeth are designed to be gentle; if discomfort persists, consult a hair care professional. |
