# Primus Classic Trail Backpacking Stove User Manual

Model: P-224383

## 1. INTRODUCTION

The Primus Classic Trail Backpacking Stove is a robust and lightweight cooking solution designed for outdoor enthusiasts. Its simple yet effective design ensures reliable performance for various outdoor cooking needs, from boiling water to preparing meals. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient use, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your stove.

## **2. SAFETY INFORMATION**

- Always use the stove in a well-ventilated area to prevent carbon monoxide buildup.
- Keep flammable materials away from the stove during operation.

- Ensure the stove is stable on a flat, non-combustible surface before lighting.
- Do not leave an operating stove unattended.
- Allow the stove to cool completely before handling or packing away.
- Store fuel canisters in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and heat sources.
- Keep out of reach of children.

### 3. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

---

The Primus Classic Trail Stove is designed for quick and easy setup.

1. **Unpack Components:** Remove the stove and its components from the nylon storage bag. The stove consists of two main parts: the burner top and the valve assembly.
2. **Assemble Stove:** Carefully screw the burner top onto the valve assembly. Ensure it is securely tightened.
3. **Connect Fuel Canister:** Place the stove on a stable, level surface. Screw the stove assembly onto a compatible threaded gas cartridge (not included). Turn clockwise until hand-tight. Do not overtighten.
4. **Check for Leaks:** After connecting the fuel, listen for any hissing sounds or apply a small amount of soapy water around the connection point. If bubbles appear, there is a leak. Disconnect and re-tighten. If the leak persists, do not use the stove.

## 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Using your Primus Classic Trail Stove is straightforward:

- 1. Ignition:** Slowly turn the control valve counter-clockwise to release a small amount of gas. Immediately ignite the gas using a match, lighter, or external igniter.
- 2. Flame Adjustment:** Once lit, adjust the flame to your desired intensity by turning the control valve. Turn clockwise to decrease the flame and counter-clockwise to increase it. The adjustable control valve allows for precise heating, from simmering to boiling.
- 3. Cooking:** Place your pot or pan securely on the crosswise pot supports. The supports also act as a built-in windscreens, improving cooking efficiency.
- 4. Extinguishing:** When finished cooking, turn the control valve fully clockwise until the flame is extinguished.
- 5. Cool Down:** Allow the stove to cool completely before disconnecting the fuel canister or packing it away.

## 5. MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and safe operation of your stove.

- **Cleaning:** After each use, ensure the stove is cool. Wipe down the stove body and pot supports with a damp cloth to remove any food residue or grime. Do not use abrasive cleaners.
- **Storage:** Disconnect the fuel canister and store the stove in its supplied nylon bag. Store in a dry place, away from extreme temperatures.
- **Inspection:** Periodically inspect the O-rings and connections for any signs of wear or damage. Replace if necessary.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Stove does not light.	No fuel, clogged jet, or faulty connection.	Check fuel level. Ensure canister is properly connected. Clean the jet if necessary (refer to advanced maintenance if comfortable).

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Weak or inconsistent flame.	Low fuel, cold temperature, or partial clog.	Replace fuel canister. Warm the canister if it's very cold. Check for partial clogs.
Gas leak detected.	Loose connection or damaged O-ring.	Tighten connections. Inspect and replace O-rings if damaged. Do not use if leak persists.



