# Schwinn Roadster 12-inch Tricycle S6728 User Manual

## 1. Introduction

Thank you for choosing the Schwinn Roadster 12-inch Tricycle. This manual contains important information regarding the safe assembly, operation, and maintenance of your tricycle. Please read it thoroughly before assembly and retain it for future reference. This tricycle is designed for children aged 18 months and up, providing a stable and enjoyable riding experience with its low center of gravity and classic design.



## 2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Always prioritize safety when operating the tricycle. Failure to follow these safety guidelines may result in injury.

- Adult Supervision: Always ensure an adult supervises children while riding the tricycle.
- **Protective Gear:** Encourage your child to wear a helmet and other protective gear (knee and elbow pads) when riding.
- **Riding Environment:** Use the tricycle on flat, paved surfaces away from traffic, steep inclines, stairs, and swimming pools. Avoid riding on uneven terrain or near hazards.
- Weight Limit: Do not exceed the recommended weight limit for the tricycle.
- **Pre-Ride Check:** Before each use, check that all bolts and nuts are securely tightened, tires are properly inflated, and the steering and braking (if applicable) mechanisms are functioning correctly.
- Footwear: Ensure the child wears closed-toe shoes while riding.

#### 3. ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Assembly is required for the Schwinn Roadster Tricycle. Please follow these steps carefully. It is recommended that two adults perform the assembly.

- 1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all parts from the packaging. Verify that all components listed in the parts diagram (not included in this manual, refer to original packaging) are present.
- Attach Front Fork and Handlebars: Insert the front fork into the main frame. Secure the handlebars into the fork stem, ensuring they are aligned with the front wheel. Tighten all bolts firmly.
- 3. **Install Front Wheel:** Attach the front wheel to the fork, ensuring the axle nuts are securely fastened.
- 4. **Assemble Rear Axle and Wheels:** Slide the rear axle through the frame. Attach the rear wheels and fenders to the axle, securing them with the provided hardware.
- 5. **Mount Wooden Deck:** Position the wooden deck onto the rear frame and secure it with the designated screws. Ensure the Schwinn logo is facing upwards.
- Attach Seat: Place the sculpted seat onto the frame. Adjust the seat position for the rider's comfort and reach to the pedals. Secure the seat using the adjustment knob located underneath.
- 7. **Install Pedals:** Thread the pedals into the crank arms. Note that pedals are typically marked 'L' for left and 'R' for right. Tighten securely.
- 8. Add Accessories: Attach the bell to the handlebar and insert the tassels into the handlebar grips.
- 9. **Final Inspection:** Double-check all connections, bolts, and nuts to ensure they are tight and secure before the first use.

## 4. OPERATING THE TRICYCLE

The Schwinn Roadster Tricycle is designed for simple and safe operation by young children.

- **Riding Position:** Ensure the child can comfortably reach the pedals and handlebars. The adjustable seat allows for optimal positioning.
- **Pedaling:** Instruct the child on how to pedal forward. The low center of gravity enhances stability, making it easier for beginners.
- **Steering:** Guide the child on how to steer using the handlebars. The cruiser-style handlebars provide a comfortable grip.
- **Using the Bell:** The tricycle is equipped with a bell. Teach the child how to use it to alert others when riding.

## 5. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will ensure the longevity and safe operation of your Schwinn Roadster Tricycle.

- Cleaning: Clean the tricycle regularly with a damp cloth and mild soap. Avoid harsh chemicals that may damage the paint or chrome finish.
- **Lubrication:** Periodically apply a small amount of bicycle-specific lubricant to the pedal axles and steering column to ensure smooth operation.
- **Tire Pressure:** Check tire pressure regularly. Maintain the recommended pressure as indicated on the tire sidewall.
- Fastener Check: Regularly inspect all nuts, bolts, and screws for tightness. Tighten any loose fasteners to prevent parts from detaching during use.
- **Storage:** Store the tricycle in a dry, covered area to protect it from weather elements, which can cause rust or material degradation.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Here are some common issues and their solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Pedals are stiff or squeaky	Lack of lubrication, dirt buildup	Clean and lubricate pedal axles.
Tricycle pulls to one side	Loose handlebar, uneven tire pressure	Check handlebar tightness and adjust tire pressure evenly.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Loose parts or rattling sounds	Loose fasteners	Inspect all nuts, bolts, and screws and tighten as necessary.
Tires appear flat	Low tire pressure, puncture	Inflate tires to recommended pressure. If still flat, check for punctures and repair or replace the inner tube.
