INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the safe and efficient use, care, and maintenance of your Sunbeam M'Sieur Crepe Electric Crepemaker. Please read all instructions carefully before operating the appliance and retain this manual for future reference.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

When using electrical appliances, basic safety precautions should always be followed to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and/or injury to persons, including the following:

- Read all instructions.
- Do not touch hot surfaces. Use handles or knobs.
- To protect against electrical shock, do not immerse cord, plugs, or appliance in water or other liquid.
- Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
- Unplug from outlet when not in use and before cleaning. Allow to cool before putting on or taking off parts, and before cleaning the appliance.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug or after the appliance malfunctions or has been damaged in any manner.
- The use of accessory attachments not recommended by the appliance manufacturer may cause injuries.
- Do not use outdoors.
- Do not let cord hang over edge of table or counter, or touch hot surfaces.
- Do not place on or near a hot gas or electric burner, or in a heated oven.
- Extreme caution must be used when moving an appliance containing hot oil or other hot liquids.
- Always attach plug to appliance first, then plug cord into the wall outlet. To disconnect, turn any control to "off", then remove plug from wall outlet.
- Do not use appliance for other than intended use.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Sunbeam M'Sieur Crepe Electric Crepemaker is designed for convenient and efficient preparation of crepes. Its non-stick surface and controlled heating element ensure consistent results for various crepe recipes.




Figure 1: Sunbeam M'Sieur Crepe Electric Crepemaker. This image displays the compact electric appliance designed for making crepes, featuring a circular heating surface and a handle for easy use.

SETUP

- Unpacking:** Carefully remove the crepemaker and all accessories from the packaging. Retain packaging for storage or shipping if needed.
- Initial Cleaning:** Before first use, wipe the cooking surface with a damp cloth and mild detergent. Rinse with a clean, damp cloth and dry thoroughly. Do not immerse the appliance in water.
- Placement:** Place the crepemaker on a stable, heat-resistant, and dry surface, away from the edge of the counter. Ensure there is adequate ventilation around the appliance.
- Power Connection:** Ensure the voltage rating of the appliance matches your household electrical supply. Plug the power cord into a grounded electrical outlet.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The M'Sieur Crepe Electric Crepemaker is designed for ease of use. Follow these steps for optimal crepe preparation:

- Preheating:** Plug in the crepemaker. Allow it to preheat for approximately 5-7 minutes, or until the indicator light (if present) signals it's ready. The cooking surface will become hot.
- Preparing Batter:** Prepare your crepe batter according to your chosen recipe. Ensure the batter is smooth and free of lumps.
- Dipping Method:** For thin crepes, pour a small amount of batter into a shallow dish. Invert the hot crepemaker cooking surface directly into the batter, ensuring an even coating. Hold for a few seconds.
- Cooking:** Return the crepemaker to its upright position. Allow the crepe to cook for 30-60 seconds, or until the edges begin to brown and the surface appears set.
- Flipping (Optional):** If desired, gently lift the edge of the crepe with a non-metallic spatula and flip it to cook the other side for an additional 15-30 seconds.
- Removing Crepe:** Once cooked, slide the crepe off the cooking surface onto a plate using a non-metallic spatula.
- Repeat:** Continue the process for remaining batter. Unplug the appliance when finished.

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Proper care ensures the longevity and performance of your crepemaker.

- **Cool Down:** Always allow the appliance to cool completely before cleaning.
- **Cleaning Surface:** Wipe the non-stick cooking surface with a soft, damp cloth or sponge. For stubborn residue, use a small amount of mild dish soap. Avoid abrasive cleaners, scouring pads, or metal utensils, as these can damage the non-stick coating.
- **Exterior Cleaning:** Wipe the exterior of the appliance with a damp cloth. Do not immerse the crepemaker in water or any other liquid.
- **Storage:** Ensure the appliance is clean and dry before storing. Store in a cool, dry place.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Crepes stick to the surface.	Surface not properly seasoned or cleaned; insufficient preheating; batter too thick.	Ensure surface is clean and lightly oiled (if recommended by manufacturer, though typically non-stick doesn't need it). Allow full preheating. Adjust batter consistency.
Crepes are unevenly cooked.	Uneven batter distribution; insufficient preheating.	Ensure the crepemaker is fully preheated. Dip the crepemaker into the batter evenly and quickly.
Appliance does not heat up.	Not plugged in; power outlet issue; internal fault.	Check if the power cord is securely plugged into a working outlet. Test the outlet with another appliance. If problem persists, contact customer support.

SPECIFICATIONS
