PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Toddleroo by North States 3-in-1 Metal Superyard is a versatile safety solution designed to provide a secure environment for children. It can be configured in three primary ways:

- **Play Yard:** A freestanding enclosure creating a safe play space.
- **Safety Gate:** A barrier to block off doorways or openings.
- **Extra Wide Baby Fence:** A long barrier to secure larger areas like fireplaces or wide openings.

COMPONENTS AND PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all components are present before beginning assembly.

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

1. Freestanding Enclosure (Play Yard) Setup

This configuration requires no tools and is ideal for creating a portable play space.

1. Unfold the panels to form the desired shape (e.g., hexagon).
2. Ensure all panel joints are securely locked in place. Twist the poles to lock for maximum security.

3. Place the Superyard on a flat, stable surface. Skid-resistant pads on the bottom will help prevent slipping and scratching floors.
4. The 6-panel configuration encloses up to 10 square feet and is 30 inches tall.

2. Hardware Mount (Gate or Barrier) Setup

For a more secure installation, the Superyard can be hardware mounted as a gate or an extra-wide barrier. This requires tools.

1. Determine the desired location for the gate/barrier.
2. Use the provided mounting template to mark drilling locations on the wall.
3. Drill pilot holes as indicated by the template.
4. Attach the wall fittings to the wall using the provided screws.
5. Securely attach the Superyard panels to the wall fittings.
6. Ensure the gate is properly aligned and swings freely.
7. When used as a barrier, it can extend up to 151 inches wide.

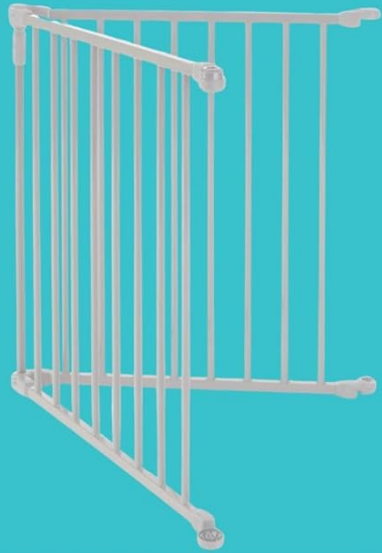

3. Adding Extension Panels (Sold Separately)

To increase the size of your play yard or barrier, 2-panel extensions are available separately.

- Follow the instructions provided with the extension kit for proper attachment.
- A 2-panel extension increases the play area to 19 square feet.
- For gate configurations, a maximum of 12 panels can be used.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Walk-Through Door Operation

The Superyard features a swinging walk-through door panel with a child-proof double-locking system for easy adult access.

1. To open: Simultaneously press the release button and lift the door handle.
2. To close: Gently push the door shut until you hear it click into the double-locking mechanism.
3. The door can stay open past 90 degrees or close automatically behind you.

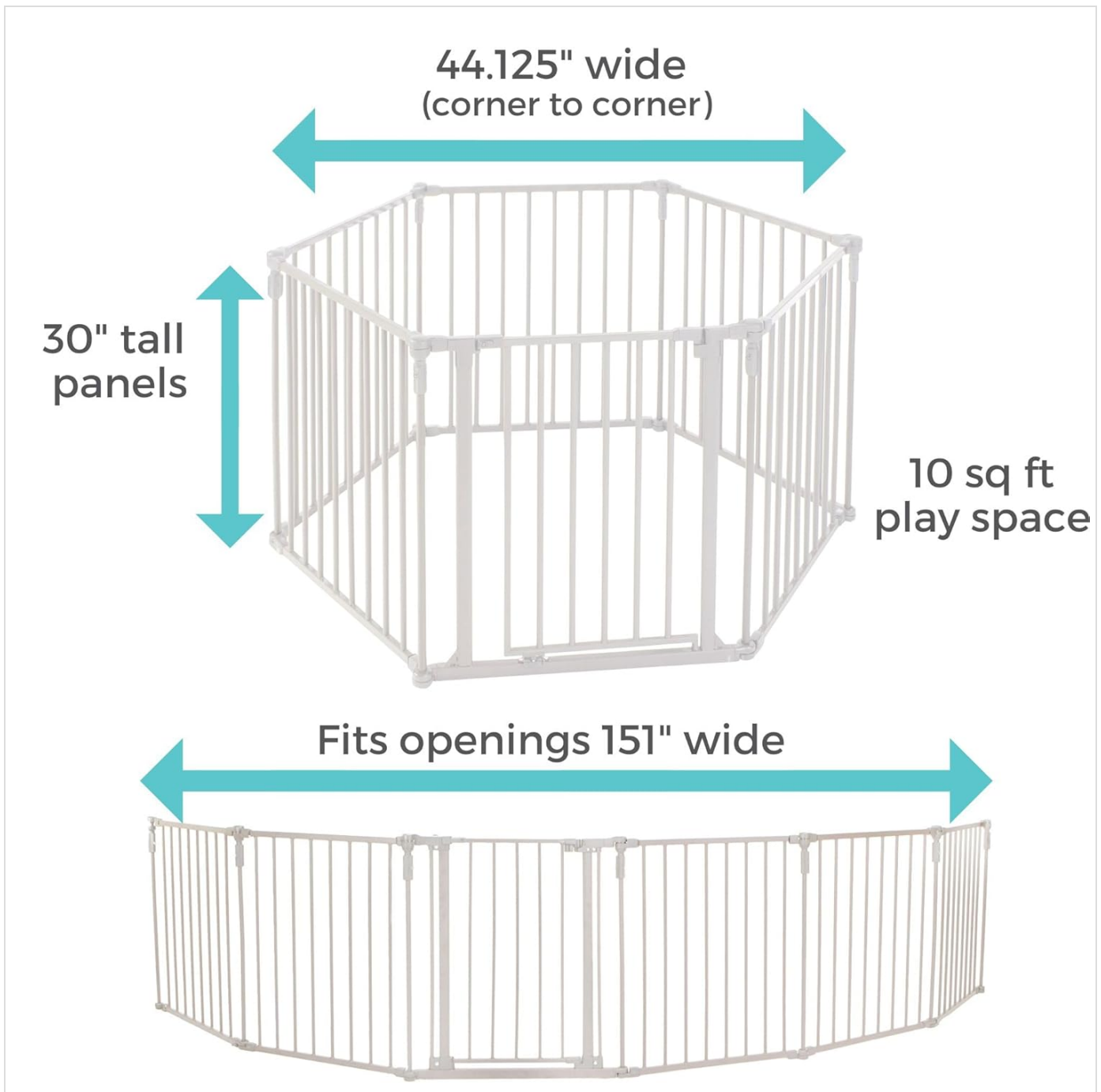
Conveniently folds up for easy transport & storage

Folding for Transport and Storage

The Superyard is designed for convenient folding, making it easy to transport and store.

1. Unlock all panel joints.
2. Accordion fold the panels together.
3. Ensure all panels are neatly stacked for compact storage.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Wipe surfaces with a damp cloth and mild soap. Do not use abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals.
- **Inspection:** Regularly inspect all parts for wear, damage, or loose components. Pay close attention to hinges, locking mechanisms, and wall mounts.
- **Storage:** When not in use, store the Superyard in a clean, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

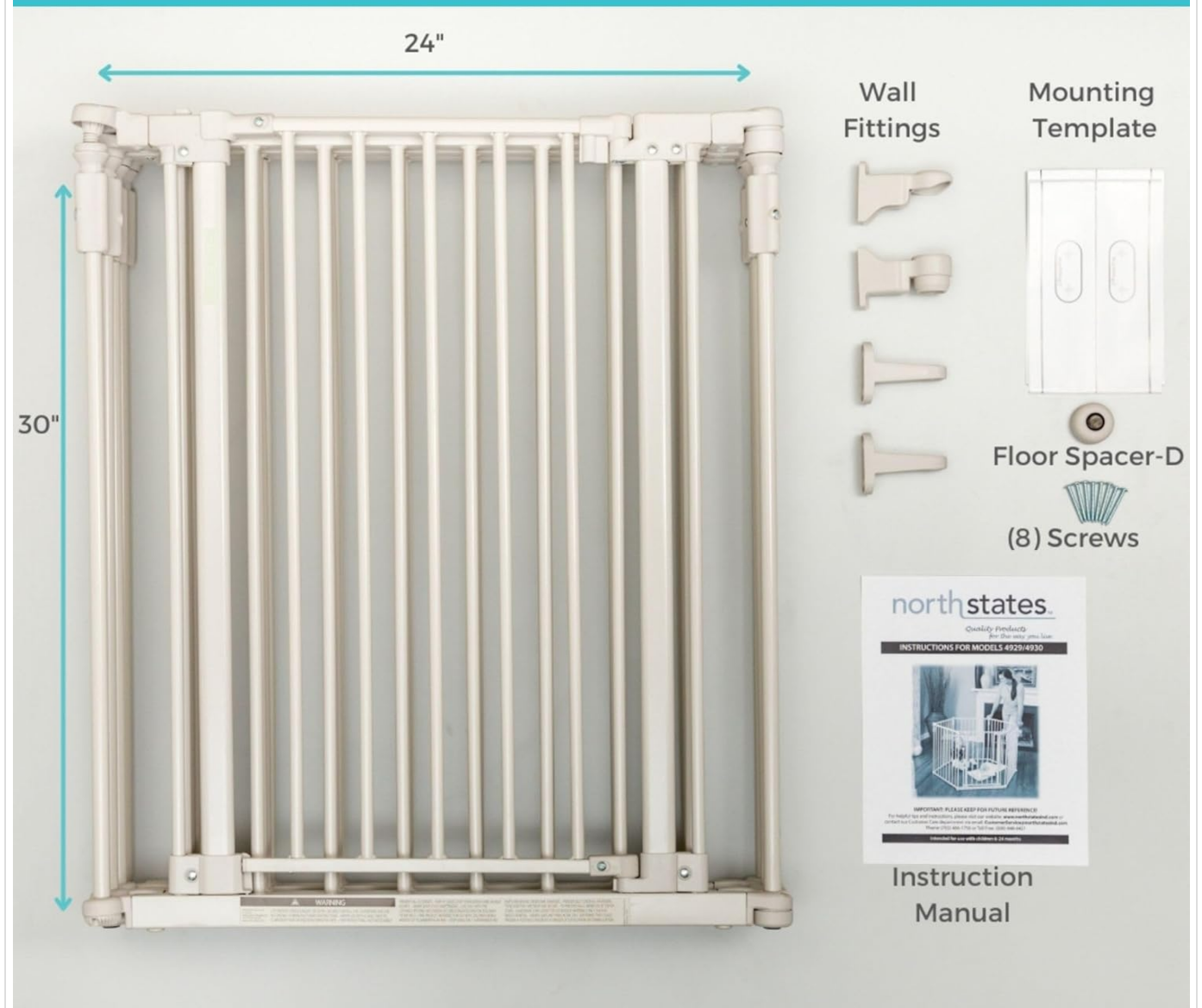
TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Gate not locking securely:** Ensure no obstructions are preventing the latch from engaging. Check that the gate is properly aligned.
- **Panels feel wobbly:** Verify that all panel joints are twisted and locked into place. For hardware-mounted configurations, ensure wall fittings are securely fastened.
- **Scratches on floor:** Confirm that the skid-resistant pads are intact and properly positioned on the bottom of the panels.
