## INTRODUCTION

---

The Guidecraft Screw Block is a multi-color matching game designed to enhance fine motor skills, hand-eye coordination, and sensory development in children aged 2 and up. This classic wooden toy provides an engaging way for toddlers to learn through hands-on manipulation.

## COMPONENTS

---

The Guidecraft Screw Block set includes the following items:

- **1 Wooden Base Block:** A sturdy block with six threaded holes.
- **6 Colorful Screws:** Wooden screws in various colors designed to fit the threaded holes.
- **1 Wooden Screwdriver:** A child-friendly screwdriver tool.

## SETUP

---

The Guidecraft Screw Block requires minimal setup. Simply remove all components from the packaging. The screwdriver is designed to fit securely in a designated slot on the base block when not in use.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

Follow these steps to engage with the Guidecraft Screw Block:

1. **Remove Screwdriver:** Gently pull the wooden screwdriver from its storage slot on the base block.
2. **Select a Screw:** Choose one of the six colorful wooden screws.
3. **Match Colors:** Identify a threaded hole on the base block that matches the color of the selected screw.
4. **Insert and Twist:** Place the screw into the matching colored hole. Use the screwdriver to twist the screw clockwise until it is securely fastened. Alternatively, children can use their fingers to twist the screws.
5. **Repeat:** Continue with the remaining screws, matching each to its corresponding colored hole.
6. **Unscrew and Replay:** To restart the activity, twist the screws counter-clockwise using the screwdriver or fingers until they are removed from the block.
7. **Storage:** After play, ensure all screws are removed and the screwdriver is placed back into its slot for safekeeping.

## MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity of your Guidecraft Screw Block, follow these simple maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the wooden components with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners, as these may damage the wood or paint.
- **Drying:** Allow all parts to air dry completely before storing to prevent moisture damage.
- **Storage:** Store the toy in a dry place away from direct sunlight or extreme temperatures to prevent warping or fading.
