INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the proper setup, operation, and maintenance of your Casio G-Shock DW-9052-2V digital watch. Please read this manual thoroughly to ensure optimal performance and longevity of your timepiece. The Casio G-Shock DW-9052-2V is designed for durability and functionality, featuring shock resistance and 200-meter water resistance.



SETUP

Initial Time and Date Setting

- 1. In the Timekeeping Mode, press and hold the **ADJUST** button until the seconds begin to flash, indicating the setting screen.
- 2. Press the **MODE** button to cycle through the settings: Seconds \rightarrow Hour \rightarrow Minute \rightarrow Year \rightarrow Month \rightarrow Day.
- 3. Use the START/STOP button to increase the flashing value or the SPLIT/RESET button to decrease it.

- 4. To switch between 12-hour and 24-hour format, press the **START/STOP** button while the hour/minute setting is flashing.
- 5. Once all settings are correct, press the ADJUST button to exit the setting screen.

Backlight Configuration

The electro-luminescent backlight can be configured to flash with alarms, the countdown timer, and the hourly time signal.

- In Timekeeping Mode, press the ADJUST button to enter setting mode.
- Cycle through settings using the MODE button until you reach the 'Flash Alert' setting (indicated by a symbol or text).
- Use the START/STOP button to toggle the Flash Alert function ON or OFF.
- · Press ADJUST to confirm and exit.

OPERATING THE WATCH

The watch features multiple modes accessible via the **MODE** button. Pressing the **MODE** button cycles through Timekeeping, Alarm, Countdown Timer, and Stopwatch modes.

Timekeeping Mode

This is the default mode, displaying the current time (hour, minute, second), day of the week, and date. Press the **LIGHT** button to illuminate the display.

Alarm Mode

To set an alarm:

- 1. From Timekeeping Mode, press MODE until 'ALM' (Alarm) appears.
- 2. Press and hold ADJUST until the alarm time digits flash.
- 3. Use MODE to select hour or minute. Use START/STOP to change the value.
- 4. Press ADJUST to set the alarm.
- 5. To activate/deactivate the alarm or hourly time signal, press **START/STOP** in Alarm Mode.

Countdown Timer Mode

The countdown timer can be set for up to 24 hours.

- 1. From Timekeeping Mode, press **MODE** until 'TMR' (Timer) appears.
- 2. Press and hold ADJUST until the timer setting flashes.
- 3. Use **MODE** to select hour, minute, or second. Use **START/STOP** to change the value.
- 4. Press ADJUST to set the timer.
- 5. Press **START/STOP** to start or stop the countdown. Press **SPLIT/RESET** to reset.

Stopwatch Mode

The stopwatch measures elapsed time in 1/100-second increments.

- 1. From Timekeeping Mode, press MODE until 'STW' (Stopwatch) appears.
- 2. Press **START/STOP** to start or stop the stopwatch.
- 3. Press SPLIT/RESET to record split times or to reset the stopwatch to zero when stopped.

Electro-Luminescent Backlight

Press the **LIGHT** button (located at the bottom center of the watch face) to illuminate the display for easy viewing in low light conditions. The illumination duration is preset.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning

- Wipe the watch with a soft, dry cloth to remove dirt and moisture.
- For stubborn dirt, use a soft cloth dampened with water and a mild neutral detergent. Avoid harsh chemicals or solvents.
- After exposure to saltwater, rinse the watch thoroughly with fresh water and dry it completely.

Water Resistance

The DW-9052-2V is water resistant to 200 meters (660 feet). This rating means it is suitable for professional marine activity and serious surface water sports. It is not suitable for scuba diving. To maintain water resistance:

- Do not operate buttons while the watch is submerged in water.
- Avoid exposing the watch to extreme temperature changes, which can affect the water resistance gaskets.
- Have the gaskets checked periodically by an authorized service center, especially after several years of use.

Battery Replacement

The watch uses one CR2 battery, which typically lasts for approximately 2 years. When the display becomes dim or functions become erratic, it is time to replace the battery. Battery replacement should be performed by a qualified technician to ensure proper sealing and water resistance.




Image: The black and red G-Shock branded product packaging box for the Casio DW-9052-2V watch. This box protects the watch during transport and storage.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Display is blank or dim.	Low battery.	Replace the battery.
Time is incorrect.	Time not set correctly or accidental adjustment.	Refer to the 'Initial Time and Date Setting' section to reset the time.
Buttons are unresponsive.	Watch may be in a specific mode or internal issue.	Ensure watch is not submerged. If issue persists, contact Casio service.
Water inside the display.	Compromised water resistance.	Immediately take the watch to an authorized service center. Do not attempt to dry it yourself.

For more complex issues or repairs, please contact an authorized Casio service center. Do not attempt to open or repair the watch yourself, as this may void the warranty and compromise its water and shock resistance.


