Philips AVENT Classic Medium Flow Nipple Instruction Manual

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Philips AVENT Classic Medium Flow Nipple is designed for bottle-fed babies aged 3 months and older. Crafted from soft, durable, and flavorless silicone, this nipple facilitates a natural latch, making the transition between breast and bottle feeding smoother.

Key features include:

- BPA-Free construction for safety.
- Clinically proven to reduce colic and discomfort.
- An anti-colic valve that promotes active feeding and minimizes air intake, thereby reducing fussiness and colic.
- Three holes for a consistent medium flow, suitable for babies at least 3 months old.
- Each pack includes two medium flow nipples.

SETUP AND FIRST USE

Before First Use:

1. Disassemble all components of the nipple and any associated bottle parts.
2. Wash all parts thoroughly in warm, soapy water.
3. Rinse all parts completely to remove any soap residue.
4. Sterilize the nipple and other bottle components. Refer to the "Maintenance and Cleaning" section for sterilization

methods.

Assembly:

To assemble the nipple with a Philips AVENT Classic bottle:

1. Insert the nipple into the screw ring from below, pulling it through until it is securely seated.
2. Ensure the anti-colic valve on the nipple aligns with the vent on the screw ring.
3. Screw the assembled nipple and screw ring onto the bottle.
4. Confirm all parts are securely fastened to prevent leaks.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS (FEEDING)

The Philips AVENT Classic Medium Flow Nipple is designed for babies 3 months and older. Always ensure the nipple's flow rate is appropriate for your baby's age and feeding needs.

1. Prepare formula or breast milk according to instructions.
2. Fill the sterilized Philips AVENT Classic bottle with the prepared liquid.
3. Attach the assembled nipple and screw ring securely to the bottle.
4. Before feeding, always check the temperature of the liquid by dripping a few drops onto your wrist. It should feel lukewarm, not hot.
5. Position your baby comfortably for feeding.
6. Ensure the anti-colic valve on the nipple is facing upwards during feeding to allow proper air circulation and reduce vacuum build-up.
7. Monitor your baby for signs of discomfort or excessive air intake. The anti-colic valve is designed to minimize these issues.
8. Do not use the nipple as a pacifier.
9. Continuous and prolonged sucking of fluids can cause tooth decay.

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Proper cleaning and maintenance are crucial for hygiene and extending the life of your Philips AVENT Classic Medium Flow Nipple.

Cleaning:

- Immediately after each use, disassemble the nipple and all bottle components.
- Wash all parts thoroughly in warm, soapy water using a soft brush or sponge. Pay special attention to the anti-colic valve and the inside of the nipple.
- Rinse all components under clean running water until all soap residue is removed.
- *Note: This product is not specified as dishwasher safe. Hand washing is recommended.*

Sterilization:

Sterilize the nipple and other bottle parts using one of the following methods:

- **Boiling:** Place all cleaned parts in a pot of boiling water for 5 minutes. Ensure there is enough water to cover all parts and prevent them from touching the bottom or sides of the pot, which could cause damage.
- **Steam Sterilizer:** Use a Philips AVENT steam sterilizer or another suitable steam sterilizer according to its instructions.
- **Cold Water Sterilization:** Use a cold water sterilization solution according to the manufacturer's instructions.

Storage:

Store cleaned and sterilized nipples in a dry, covered container away from direct sunlight and heat.

Inspection:

Before each use, inspect the nipple for any signs of wear, tear, stickiness, or damage. Pull the nipple in all directions to check for weakness. Discard and replace the nipple immediately if any damage is observed, as this could pose a choking

hazard.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Nipple leaks during feeding.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Nipple not securely seated in the screw ring.• Screw ring not tightened properly on the bottle.• Nipple is damaged or worn.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Ensure the nipple is pulled completely through the screw ring and seated correctly.• Tighten the screw ring firmly onto the bottle, but do not overtighten.• Inspect the nipple for cracks or tears. Replace if damaged.
Baby struggles to feed or flow is too slow.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Nipple holes are blocked.• Nipple flow rate is too slow for baby's age/needs.• Anti-colic valve is blocked or not functioning.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Clean nipple holes thoroughly.• Consider switching to a faster flow nipple if your baby is older or requires a quicker flow.• Ensure the anti-colic valve is clean and clear.
Baby is taking in too much air or experiencing colic.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Nipple flow rate is too fast for baby's age/needs.• Anti-colic valve is not positioned correctly or is blocked.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Consider switching to a slower flow nipple if your baby is younger or struggles with the current flow.• Ensure the anti-colic valve is facing upwards during feeding and is clear of obstructions.
