## INTRODUCTION

---

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the installation, operation, and maintenance of your CORNAT NO5 Single Hole Mixer for Sink Unit. - Always turn off the main water supply before beginning any installation or maintenance.
- Ensure all connections are secure to prevent leaks.
- If you are unsure about any part of the installation process, consult a qualified plumber.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals on the faucet's finish.
- Keep small parts away from children.

## PRODUCT OVERVIEW

---

The CORNAT NO5 Single Hole Mixer is designed for easy integration into your sink unit. Key features include:

- **Aerator M22 x 1:** Provides a smooth, splash-free water flow and can be easily removed for cleaning.
- **With eyelet for a chain:** Allows for attachment of a sink stopper chain.
- **Single Hole Installation:** Simplifies mounting on compatible sinks.
- **Two Handles:** Separate controls for hot and cold water.
- **Chrome Finish:** Durable and easy to clean, providing a sleek appearance.




Figure 2: Dimensional drawing of the CORNAT NO5 faucet, indicating a height of 290mm and a spout reach of 165mm from the center of the base.

## SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Before you begin, ensure you have all necessary tools and components. It is recommended to have a basin wrench, adjustable wrench, plumber's putty or silicone sealant, and a screwdriver.

### Installation Steps:

1. **Prepare the Sink:** Ensure the mounting hole on your sink or countertop is clean and free of debris.

## 2. Mount the Faucet:

- Apply a thin bead of plumber's putty or silicone sealant around the base of the faucet.
- Insert the faucet's supply lines and mounting shank through the hole in the sink.
- From underneath the sink, slide the rubber washer, metal washer, and mounting nut onto the mounting shank.
- Hand-tighten the mounting nut, then use a basin wrench to fully secure the faucet, ensuring it is straight and centered.

## 3. Connect Water Supply Lines:

- Connect the hot water supply line from the faucet to the hot water shut-off valve.
- Connect the cold water supply line from the faucet to the cold water shut-off valve.
- Tighten all connections securely with an adjustable wrench, but do not overtighten.

## 4. Check for Leaks:

- Slowly turn on the main water supply.
- Open both hot and cold faucet handles to allow water to flow and flush out any debris.
- Inspect all connections for leaks. If leaks are present, tighten the connections slightly until they stop.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

The CORNAT NO5 mixer features two distinct handles for precise control over water temperature and flow.

- **Cold Water:** Turn the right handle counter-clockwise to open the cold water flow. Turn clockwise to close.
- **Hot Water:** Turn the left handle counter-clockwise to open the hot water flow. Turn clockwise to close.
- **Temperature Mixing:** Adjust both handles simultaneously to achieve your desired water temperature.
- **Flow Control:** The further you turn the handles, the greater the water flow.

## MAINTENANCE

---

Regular maintenance will help prolong the life and appearance of your CORNAT faucet.

- **Cleaning the Finish:** Clean the faucet regularly with a soft cloth and mild soap and water. Rinse thoroughly and dry with a soft cloth to prevent water spots. Avoid abrasive cleaners, harsh chemicals, or scouring pads, as these can damage the chrome finish.
- **Aerator Maintenance:** If water flow becomes restricted or uneven, the aerator may be clogged with mineral deposits.
  - a. Unscrew the aerator (M22 x 1) from the end of the spout.
  - b. Disassemble the aerator and rinse all parts under running water.
  - c. If necessary, soak the parts in a solution of equal parts white vinegar and water to dissolve mineral deposits.
  - d. Reassemble the aerator and screw it back onto the spout.
- **Leak Prevention:** Periodically check under the sink for any signs of leaks around the connections. Tighten connections as needed.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

---

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
---------	----------------	----------

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Low Water Flow	Clogged aerator; partially closed shut-off valve; debris in supply lines.	Clean the aerator (see Maintenance section). Ensure shut-off valves are fully open. Flush supply lines.
Leaking at Faucet Base	Loose mounting nut; improper sealant application.	Tighten the mounting nut. If problem persists, reapply plumber's putty or silicone sealant.
Leaking from Handles/Spout	Worn O-rings or cartridges.	Contact customer support for replacement parts or professional assistance.
No Water Flow	Main water supply off; shut-off valves closed; severely clogged lines.	Check main water supply. Ensure shut-off valves are open. Consult a plumber if lines are severely clogged.
