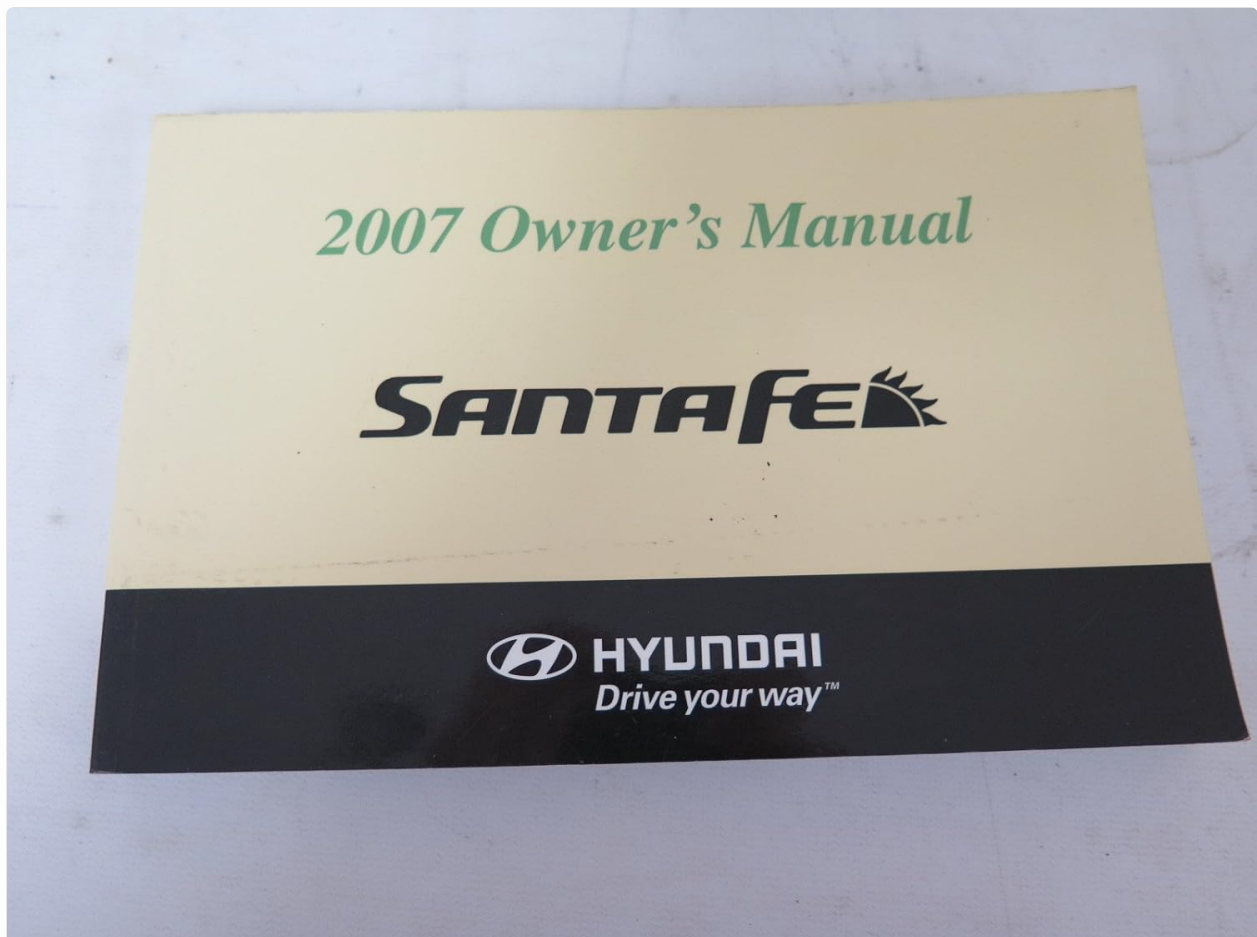

INTRODUCTION

This owner's manual is designed to provide 2007 Hyundai Santa Fe owners with essential information regarding the safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and care of their vehicle. It contains detailed instructions and important warnings to ensure a comprehensive understanding of the vehicle's features and systems. SETUP AND INITIAL INFORMATION

Service Station Information

- **Fuel:** Use UNLEADED gasoline only. Pump Octane Rating of 87 (Research Octane Number 91) or higher is recommended.
- **Fuel Tank Capacity:** Original, US gal (Imp. gal., liter) 19.8 (16.5, 75).
- **Tire Pressure:** Refer to the label on the driver's side of the center pillar outer panel for specific tire pressure recommendations.
- **Hood Release:** Pull the handle under the left side of the dash to open the hood.

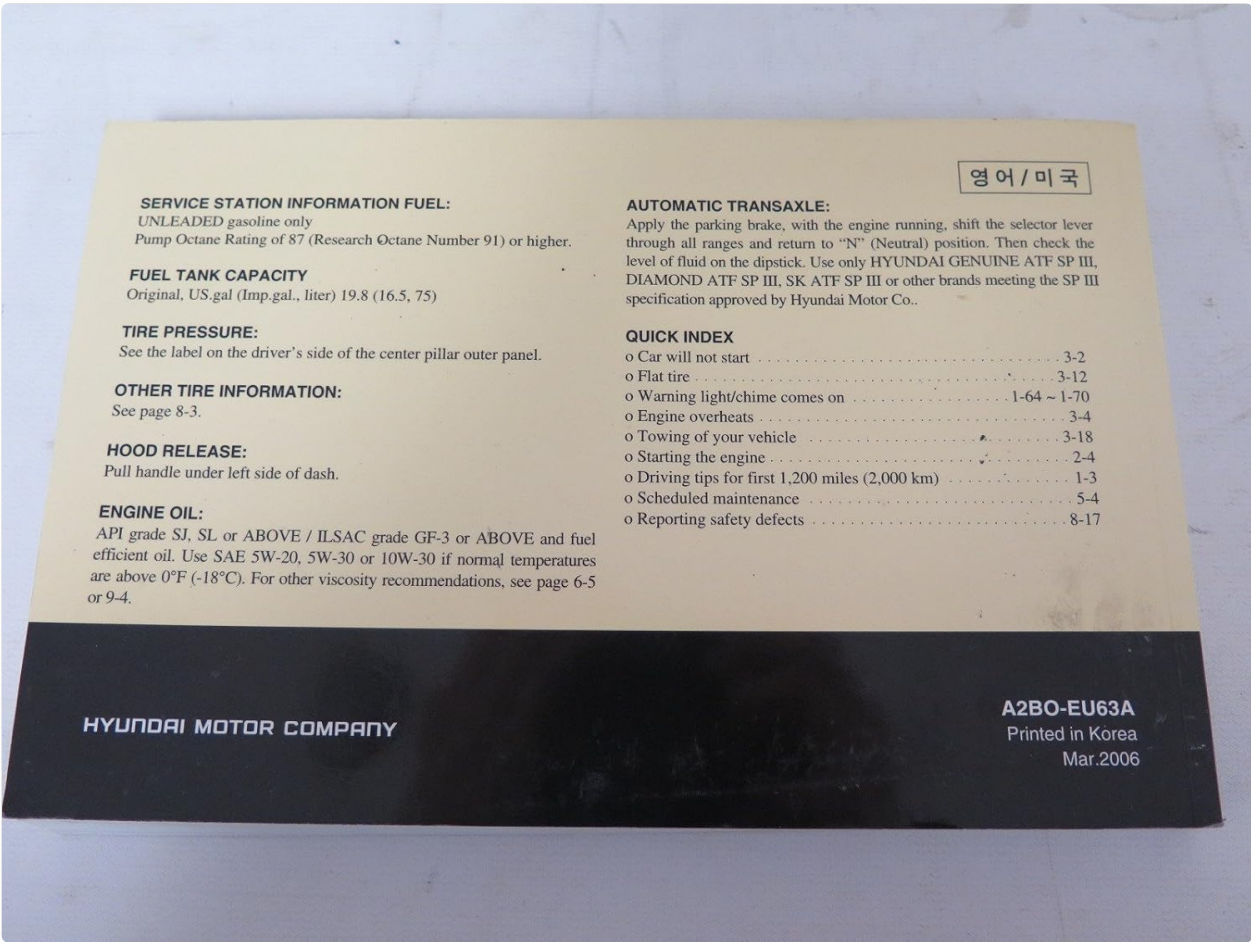


Image: An interior page from the manual detailing service station information, automatic transaxle fluid, and a quick index of common topics.

OPERATING YOUR VEHICLE

This section provides guidance on the general operation of your 2007 Hyundai Santa Fe, including starting procedures and important driving considerations.

Automatic Transaxle Operation

To operate the automatic transaxle, apply the parking brake, with the engine running, shift the selector lever through all ranges and return to "N" (Neutral) position. Check the level of fluid on the dipstick. Use only HYUNDAI GENUINE ATF SP III, DIAMOND ATF SP III, SK ATF SP III or other brands meeting the SP III specification approved by Hyundai Motor Co.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance is crucial for the longevity and performance of your Hyundai Santa Fe. This section outlines key maintenance procedures and recommendations.

Engine Oil

For optimal engine performance and protection, use API grade SJ, SL or ABOVE / ILSAC grade GF-3 or ABOVE and fuel efficient oil. Use SAE 5W-20, 5W-30 or 10W-30 if normal temperatures are above 0°F (-18°C). For other viscosity recommendations, refer to page 6-5 or 9-4 of the manual.

Scheduled Maintenance

The manual provides a detailed schedule for routine maintenance tasks. Adhering to this schedule ensures your vehicle remains in optimal condition and helps prevent potential issues. Consult the relevant section in the manual for specific intervals and procedures.

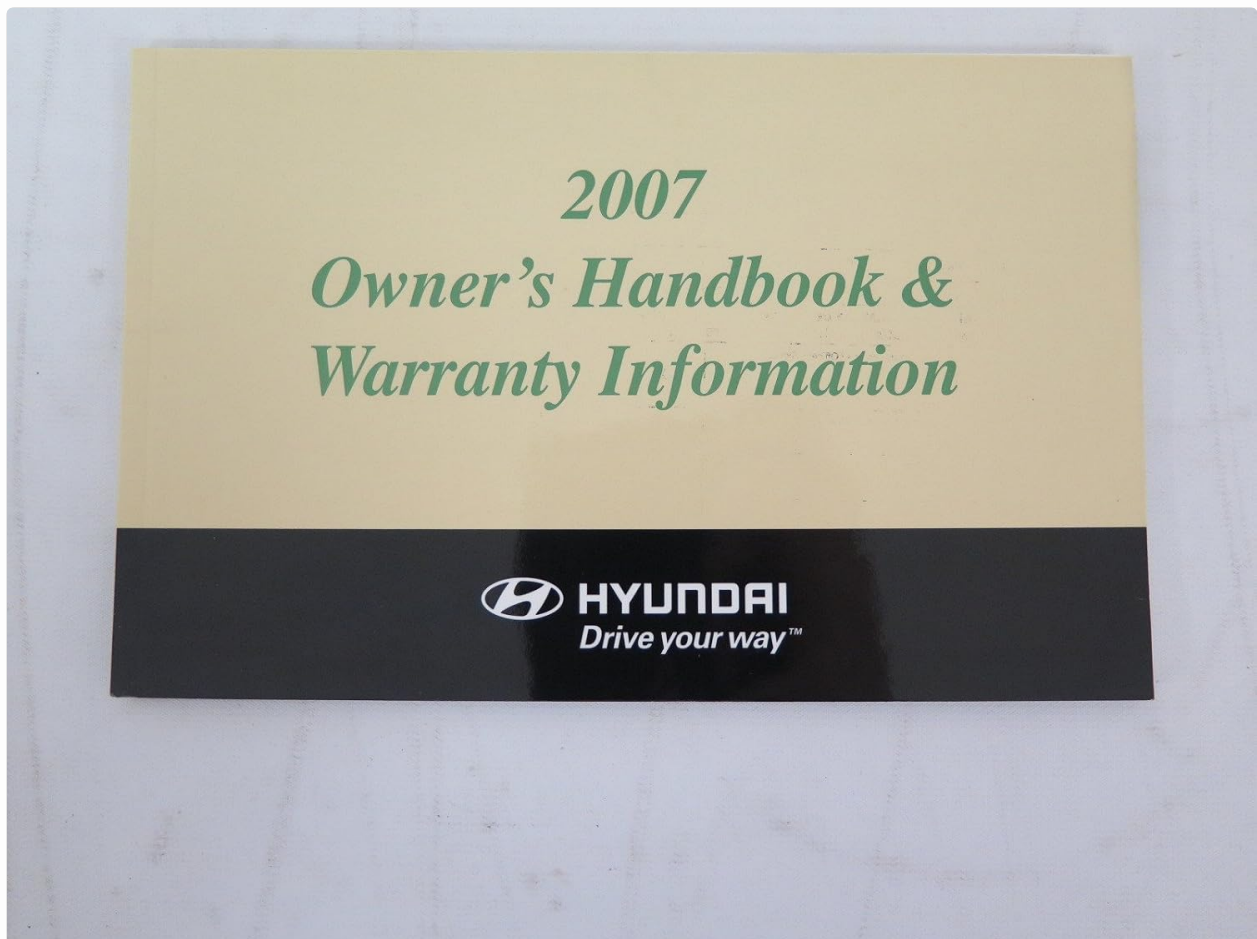


Image: Front cover of the 2007 Owner's Handbook & Warranty Information, indicating the inclusion of warranty details.
