1. INTRODUCTION

This instruction manual provides detailed guidance for assembling the Tamiya 24218 1:24 Scale Subaru Impreza WRC '99 model kit. This kit allows enthusiasts to recreate the iconic rally car with precision and detail. Please read through all instructions carefully before beginning assembly to ensure a smooth and enjoyable building experience.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

4. ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS (SETUP)

Assembly of the Tamiya Subaru Impreza WRC '99 model kit involves several stages. Refer to the detailed diagrams and step-by-step instructions provided in the physical manual included with your kit for precise guidance.

4.1. Preparation

- **Read Instructions:** Thoroughly review the entire instruction manual before starting.
- **Gather Tools:** Prepare necessary tools such as nippers, hobby knife, files, sandpaper, tweezers, and model cement.
- **Workspace:** Ensure a clean, well-lit, and well-ventilated workspace.

4.2. Part Removal and Cleaning

- Carefully cut parts from the sprues using nippers.

- Trim any excess plastic (flash) or nubs using a hobby knife or file.
- Wash parts with mild soap and water to remove mold release agents, then allow them to dry completely.

4.3. Step-by-Step Assembly

Follow the numbered steps and diagrams in the included paper manual. Each step typically involves:

1. Identifying the required parts by their sprue letter and part number.
2. Attaching parts using model cement. Apply sparingly to avoid damaging the plastic.
3. Allowing sufficient drying time for adhesive before proceeding to the next step.
4. Assembling sub-assemblies such as the engine, chassis, interior, and body separately before combining them.

5. PAINTING AND DECAL APPLICATION

Painting and decal application are crucial for achieving a realistic finish for your model.

5.1. Painting

- **Color Codes:** The instruction manual provides specific Tamiya paint color codes for each part.
- **Preparation:** Ensure parts are clean and free of dust before painting. Priming is recommended for better paint adhesion and a uniform finish.

- **Application:** Apply paint in thin, even coats. Allow each coat to dry thoroughly before applying the next.
- **Detail Painting:** Use fine brushes for small details and masking tape for sharp lines.

5.2. Decal Application

- **Preparation:** Apply a gloss clear coat to the areas where decals will be placed to prevent 'silvering'.
- **Cutting:** Carefully cut out each decal from the sheet.
- **Soaking:** Dip the decal in lukewarm water for a few seconds until it can slide freely from the backing paper.
- **Placement:** Slide the decal onto the model surface. Use tweezers and a soft brush to position it correctly.
- **Setting Solutions:** Use decal setting solutions to help the decal conform to irregular surfaces and eliminate air bubbles.
- **Sealing:** Once decals are dry, apply a final clear coat (gloss or matte, depending on desired finish) to protect them.

6. MAINTENANCE

Once assembled, your Tamiya model requires minimal maintenance to preserve its appearance.

- **Cleaning:** Dust your model regularly with a soft, dry brush or a microfiber cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- **Storage:** Store the model in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight, which can cause paint fading and plastic degradation.

- **Handling:** Handle the model carefully, avoiding excessive pressure on delicate parts.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Encountering issues during model assembly is common. Here are some general tips:

- **Parts Not Fitting:** Ensure you are using the correct parts for the step. Sometimes, a small amount of sanding or filing may be required for a perfect fit.
- **Paint Issues:** If paint appears uneven or peels, ensure the surface was clean and primed, and that paint was applied in thin coats. Humidity can also affect paint drying.
- **Decal Silvering:** This occurs when air is trapped under the decal. Ensure a gloss surface before application and use decal setting solutions.
- **Missing Parts:** Double-check the sprues and packaging. If a part is genuinely missing, contact Tamiya customer support or your retailer.


