SETUP AND USAGE

1. Inserting Your Keyboard

Unzip the main compartment of the case completely. Carefully place your slim 88-note keyboard into the case. Ensure it sits centered and flat within the padded interior.

2. Securing the Keyboard

Utilize the adjustable padded straps located inside the case. Position these straps over your keyboard to hold it firmly in place, preventing movement during transit. Fasten the Velcro closures securely.

3. Utilizing Accessory Compartments

The case features large exterior zippered pockets. Use these compartments to store accessories such as power adapters, sustain pedals, cables, headphones, and sheet music. Organize items to prevent damage.

OPERATING AND TRANSPORT

1. Using the Wheels and Pull Handle

For easy mobility, tilt the case onto its built-in wheels and extend the tow handle. Pull the case smoothly behind you. The wheels are designed for stable and effortless transport over various surfaces.

2. Carrying the Case

For lifting or carrying over short distances, use the reinforced carry handles located on the top and sides of the case. Ensure a firm grip, especially when lifting a loaded case.

3. Skid Bars for Protection

The case is equipped with rubber skid bars on the bottom. These provide an additional layer of protection against wear and tear when the case is placed on rough surfaces and help prevent slipping.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the exterior nylon with a damp cloth and mild soap as needed. For the interior, a soft brush or vacuum can remove dust and debris. Ensure the case is completely dry before storing.
- **Zipper Care:** Periodically check zippers for smooth operation. If they become stiff, apply a small amount of zipper lubricant or wax.
- **Storage:** Store the case in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures to preserve material integrity.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Keyboard Not Fitting Snugly:** Ensure all internal padded straps are adjusted and tightened correctly. If there is still excessive space, additional foam padding (not included) can be used to fill gaps.
- **Stiff Zippers:** Apply a silicone-based lubricant or beeswax to the zipper teeth. Open and close the zipper several times to distribute the lubricant.
- **Wheels Not Rolling Smoothly:** Check for any debris or hair caught in the wheel axles. Clean as necessary. If wheels are damaged, contact customer support for replacement options.
