1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the safe assembly, operation, and maintenance of your Intex 14.75' x 86" x 33" Rectangular Frame Above Ground Swimming Pool. Please read all instructions carefully before setup and use to ensure a safe and enjoyable experience.

2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Safety is paramount when using any swimming pool. Adhere to all warnings and instructions to prevent serious injury or drowning.

- **Supervise Children:** Always supervise children and inexperienced swimmers. Never leave them unattended. Designate a "Water Watcher" to ensure constant vigilance.
- **Secure the Pool:** Implement layers of protection to prevent unsupervised access. This includes properly fencing the pool with a non-climbable fence, using self-closing and self-latching gates, and securing windows. Always remove or secure the ladder when the pool is not in use.

- **Learn to Swim:** Encourage everyone to learn basic water safety tips and swimming skills.
- **Learn Life-Saving Techniques:** Get training in basic water rescue skills, first aid, and CPR. Have rescue equipment and a charged phone by the pool in case of emergency.
- **Avoid the Drain:** Suction from a pool's drain can be powerful. Do not play or swim near drains or suction outlets, and never enter a pool or spa with a loose, broken, or missing drain cover.

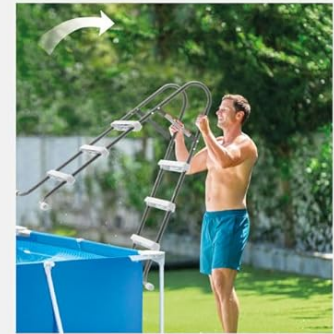
SUPERVISE

Never take your eyes off children in and around the water – not for a minute! Drowning is silent. Designate a Water Watcher.



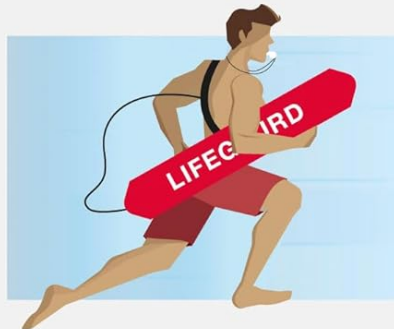
SECURE THE POOL

Use layers of protection to prevent children from gaining unsupervised access to the pool: (1) Properly fence the pool with a non-climbable fence with a self-closing and self-latching gate. (2) Secure doors, gates and windows with alarms to alert you to children wandering into the pool area. (3) Always remove or secure the ladder when the pool is not in use.



LEARN TO SWIM

Everyone should learn to swim and learn basic water safety tips.



LEARN LIFE-SAVING TECHNIQUES

Get training in basic water rescue skills, first aid and CPR. Have rescue equipment and a charged phone by the pool in case of emergency.



AVOID THE DRAIN

Suction from a pool's drain is so powerful it can trap an adult underwater. Do not play or swim near drains or suction outlets, and never enter a pool or spa with a loose, broken or missing drain cover.

3. COMPONENTS LIST

Your Intex Rectangular Frame Pool package includes the following main components:

- Pool Liner (Heavy-duty PVC and polyester 3-ply side walls)
- Pool Frame (Durable rust-resistant metal tubes and innovative T-joints)

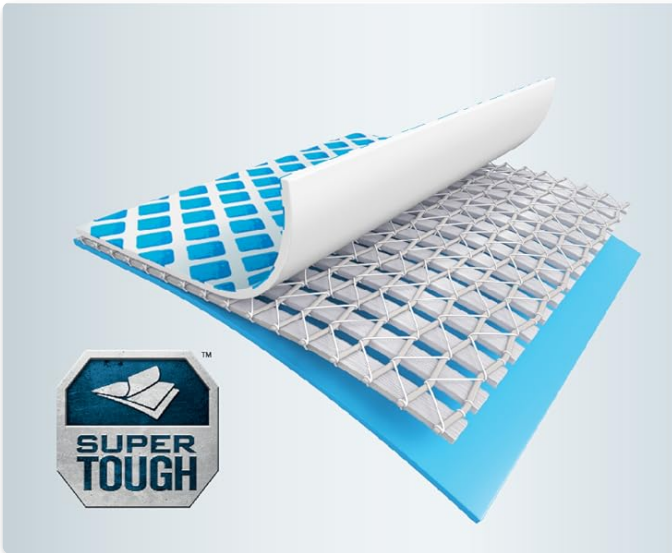
Note: Ladder, cover, and filter pump are not included and must be purchased separately.



Advanced Structure

Oversized metal tubes on the frame mean 21% more anti-bending strength.

4. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps for quick and easy assembly:

1. **Prepare the Ground:** Select a firm, level surface for your pool. Clear the area of any sharp objects, debris, or uneven terrain.
2. **Lay Out Pool Liner:** Unfold the pool liner and lay it out on the prepared ground. Ensure the drain plug is positioned correctly.
3. **Assemble Frame:** Connect the metal frame components according to the diagrams provided in the separate assembly guide. The innovative T-joints allow for tool-free assembly. Ensure all poles are securely fitted.
4. **Fill with Water:** Once the frame is fully assembled and the liner is smooth, begin filling the pool with water. As the water level rises, smooth out any wrinkles in the liner from the center outwards.

5. OPERATING THE POOL

Your Intex pool is designed for recreational use. For optimal water quality and safety, consider the following:

- **Filter Pump Connection:** The pool is equipped with connections for an optional filter pump. Connecting a filter pump (sold separately) is highly recommended for maintaining water clarity and hygiene.
- **Water Treatment:** Use appropriate pool chemicals to maintain balanced water chemistry and prevent algae growth. Consult a pool supply professional for guidance on chemical usage.
- **Hydro Aeration Technology:** If using a compatible Intex filter pump with Hydro Aeration Technology, this feature improves water circulation, clarity, and freshness by introducing air into the water.

6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance is crucial for the longevity of your pool and the quality of its water.

- **Cleaning:** Regularly skim debris from the water surface and vacuum the pool floor. Clean the pool liner as needed.
- **Water Chemistry:** Test water chemistry regularly (pH, chlorine, alkalinity) and adjust as necessary to maintain safe and clean swimming conditions.
- **Filter Maintenance:** If using a filter pump, clean or replace filter cartridges as recommended by the pump manufacturer.
- **Draining:** The pool features a convenient flow control valve for quick and easy draining when not in use or for seasonal storage. Connect a garden hose to the valve to direct water away from the pool area.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Pool water is cloudy/green	Improper water chemistry, insufficient filtration, algae growth.	Test water, adjust chemicals (chlorine, pH), clean/replace filter cartridge, shock treat the pool.
Water level dropping	Leak in liner, evaporation.	Check for visible leaks and use a patch kit if necessary. Normal evaporation occurs, especially in hot weather.
Frame appears unstable/bowing	Uneven ground, improper assembly of poles.	Ensure pool is on perfectly level ground. Recheck all frame connections to ensure they are fully inserted and snug.

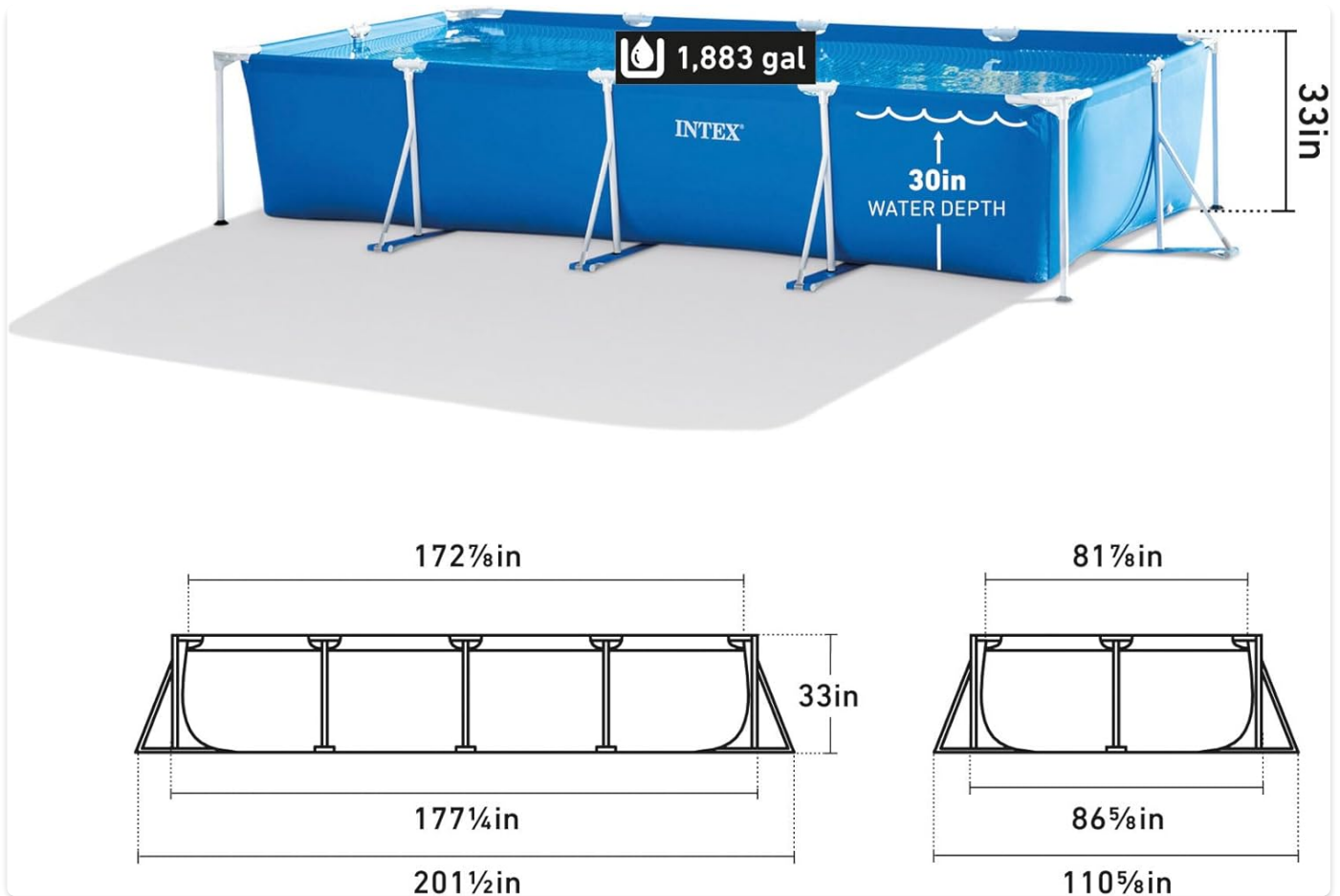


Image: A detailed diagram illustrating the dimensions of the pool, including overall length, width, height, and water depth.
