SETUP AND INSTALLATION

The Moen Brantford Faucet is designed for easy installation with its 4-inch centerset configuration. Follow these general steps for installation. For detailed, step-by-step instructions, please refer to the included installation guide in your product packaging.

1. **Prepare the Sink:** Ensure your bathroom sink has a minimum deck thickness of 5/16 inch (8mm) and a maximum of 3/4 inch (20mm). Clean the faucet mounting area thoroughly.
2. **Install the Faucet:** Place the faucet body onto the sink deck, aligning the holes. Secure it from underneath the sink using the provided mounting hardware.
3. **Connect Water Supply Lines:** Attach the hot and cold water supply lines (not included) to the corresponding inlets on the faucet and to your home's water supply. Ensure all connections are tight to prevent leaks.
4. **Install the Drain Assembly:** Follow the instructions for installing the included drain assembly into the sink drain hole. Connect the drain lift rod to the faucet's lift rod mechanism.
5. **Test for Leaks:** Turn on the water supply and check all connections for any leaks. Operate both hot and cold handles to ensure proper water flow and temperature mixing.

Professional installation is recommended if you are unfamiliar with plumbing procedures.

OPERATION

Operating your Moen Brantford Faucet is straightforward:

- **Water Flow:** The two lever handles control the water flow. Turn the left handle for hot water and the right handle for cold water.
- **Temperature Control:** Adjust the water temperature by mixing hot and cold water using both handles.
- **Aerated Stream:** The faucet provides an aerated stream, which is efficient for everyday tasks like washing hands and brushing teeth.
- **Drain Stopper:** Use the lift rod located behind the faucet spout to open and close the drain stopper.




Image: Moen Brantford Faucet in operation, demonstrating water flow.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

To keep your Moen Brantford Faucet looking and performing its best, follow these maintenance tips:

- **Cleaning:** Clean the chrome finish regularly with a soft, damp cloth and mild soap. Avoid abrasive cleaners, harsh chemicals, or scouring pads, as these can damage the finish.

- **Fingerprint Resistance:** The chrome finish is designed to be highly reflective and easy to clean, minimizing visible fingerprints.
- **Aerator Maintenance:** If water flow decreases, the aerator may be clogged. Unscrew the aerator from the spout, clean any debris, and reattach it.
- **Leak Prevention:** Periodically check all connections for tightness to prevent leaks.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Here are solutions to common issues you might encounter:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Low Water Flow	Clogged aerator or partially closed shut-off valves.	Clean the aerator. Ensure hot and cold shut-off valves under the sink are fully open.
Leaking from Spout	Worn-out cartridge or seals.	Contact Moen customer support for replacement parts or service.
Leaking from Base	Loose mounting nuts or damaged O-rings.	Tighten mounting nuts. Inspect and replace O-rings if damaged.
Difficulty Adjusting Temperature	Faulty cartridge or mineral buildup.	Flush water lines. If issue persists, replace cartridge.
