## 1. INTRODUCTION

Welcome to the Parker Brothers Monopoly 1935 Commemorative Edition. This unique edition replicates the original 1935 Parker Brothers board game, from its illustrated classic cover design to its famous game components. It features reissued original tokens in a gold-tone finish, the very first game board design, wooden houses, "Grand" hotels, ivory-hued dice, and 1935 mint cash. This edition is presented in a quality gift tin and includes a specially written Monopoly story, making it a valuable keepsake for enthusiasts of timeless American traditions.

## 2. SAFETY INFORMATION

## 3. COMPONENTS

The Parker Brothers Monopoly 1935 Commemorative Edition includes the following components:

- Title Deed Cards

## 4. SETUP

Follow these steps to set up your Monopoly game:

1. Place the game board on a flat surface.
2. Separate the Chance and Community Chest cards, shuffle each pile, and place them face down on their designated spaces on the board.
3. Each player selects one gold-tone token to represent them during the game.
4. One player is designated as the Banker. The Banker is responsible for all money, Title Deeds, Houses, and Hotels not yet owned by players. The Banker also collects taxes and fines and pays salaries and bonuses.
5. The Banker distributes starting money to each player. Refer to the original rules for the exact distribution amounts.
6. Place the Houses and Hotels near the board, ready for purchase.
7. Each player rolls both dice. The player with the highest total starts the game. In case of a tie, roll again.

## 5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS (GAMEPLAY)

Monopoly is a game of property trading where players aim to become the wealthiest by buying, renting, and trading property. The objective is to drive opponents into bankruptcy.

### Player Turn Sequence:

1. **Roll Dice:** Roll both dice and move your token clockwise around the board the number of spaces indicated.
2. **Action on Space:** The action you take depends on the space your token lands on:
  - **Unowned Property:** You may buy it from the Bank at the price printed on the space. If you choose not to buy it, the Banker immediately offers it for auction to the highest bidder.
  - **Owned Property:** If another player owns it, you must pay rent according to the Title Deed card.
  - **Chance or Community Chest:** Draw the top card from the respective pile and follow its instructions.
  - **Tax Spaces:** Pay the indicated tax to the Bank.
  - **Go to Jail:** Move your token directly to the "In Jail" space. You do not collect \$200 for passing GO.
  - **Free Parking:** No action required.

- **GO:** If you land on or pass GO, collect \$200 from the Bank.

3. **Doubles:** If you roll doubles, take your turn as usual, then roll the dice again for another turn. If you roll doubles three times in a row, you go directly to Jail.
4. **End Turn:** Once your action is complete, the turn passes to the player on your left.

### Building and Trading:

- **Houses and Hotels:** Once you own all properties in a color group, you can begin building houses and hotels on them. Buildings must be erected evenly across the properties in a group.
- **Trading:** Players can trade properties, money, and "Get Out of Jail Free" cards with each other at any time.

## 6. MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity of your Monopoly 1935 Commemorative Edition:

- Store all game components neatly in the provided tin box when not in use.
- Keep the game away from direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, and moisture to prevent warping of the board or damage to components.
- Clean the game board and plastic components with a soft, dry cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- Handle the money and cards with care to prevent tearing or creasing.
- Periodically check for any missing pieces.
