Casio TQ359/1 Alarm Clock User Manual

Model: TQ359/1

1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Casio TQ359/1 Alarm Clock. This analog quartz alarm clock is designed for reliability and ease of use, featuring a clear display, a loud alarm, a convenient snooze function, and an integrated light for visibility in low light conditions. This manual will guide you through the setup, operation, and maintenance of your new alarm clock.

2. SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

- Do not expose the clock to extreme temperatures, direct sunlight, or high humidity.
- Avoid dropping the clock or subjecting it to strong impacts.
- Keep out of reach of small children.
- Dispose of used batteries properly according to local regulations.
- Do not attempt to disassemble or repair the clock yourself. Refer to qualified service personnel.

4. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Familiarize yourself with the main components of your Casio TQ359/1 Alarm Clock.

Key Components:

- **Time Setting Knob:** Located on the back, used to adjust the current time.
- **Alarm Setting Knob:** Located on the back, used to set the desired alarm time.
- **Alarm ON/OFF Switch:** Typically a slide switch on the side or back to activate/deactivate the alarm.
- **Snooze/Light Button:** Large button on top, activates snooze when alarm sounds, or illuminates the dial when pressed.
- **Battery Compartment:** Located on the back, holds the AA battery.

5. SETUP

5.1. Battery Installation

1. Open the battery compartment cover located on the back of the clock.
2. Insert one AA battery, ensuring the correct polarity (+ and -) as indicated inside the compartment.
3. Close the battery compartment cover securely.

5.2. Initial Time Setting

1. Locate the **Time Setting Knob** on the back of the clock.
2. Rotate the knob clockwise or counter-clockwise to set the current time. Ensure the hour and minute hands are accurately aligned.

6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1. Setting the Alarm

1. Locate the **Alarm Setting Knob** on the back of the clock.
2. Rotate this knob to move the small alarm hand to your desired alarm time.
3. Slide the **Alarm ON/OFF Switch** (usually on the side or back) to the 'ON' position. The alarm is now set.

6.2. Using the Snooze Function

When the alarm sounds, press the large **Snooze/Light Button** on the top of the clock. The alarm will temporarily stop and sound again after approximately 5 minutes.

6.3. Activating the Light

To illuminate the clock face in the dark, press and hold the **Snooze/Light Button** on the top of the clock. The light will remain on as long as the button is pressed.

6.4. Turning Off the Alarm

To permanently turn off the alarm, slide the **Alarm ON/OFF Switch** to the 'OFF' position. The alarm will not sound again until it is reactivated.

7. MAINTENANCE

7.1. Cleaning

Wipe the clock with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners, solvents, or chemical sprays, as these may damage the casing or dial.

7.2. Battery Replacement

When the clock hands start to move slowly, or the alarm sound weakens, it is time to replace the battery. Follow the battery installation steps in Section 5.1.

7.3. Storage

If you plan not to use the clock for an extended period, remove the battery to prevent leakage and damage to the clock's internal components. Store the clock in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
---------	----------------	----------

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Clock not working / Hands not moving	Battery is dead or incorrectly installed.	Replace the battery with a new AA battery, ensuring correct polarity.
Alarm does not sound	Alarm switch is OFF. Alarm time is not set correctly. Battery is low.	Slide the alarm switch to ON. Re-set the alarm time. Replace the battery.
Alarm is too quiet	Battery is low.	Replace the battery.
Light is dim or not working	Battery is low.	Replace the battery.


