INTRODUCTION

The Creative Inspire T10 2.0 Multimedia Speaker System is designed to deliver high-quality audio for your PC, notebook, or MP3 player. Featuring a sleek, compact design and BasXPort Technology, these speakers provide enhanced audio performance without the need for a separate subwoofer. This manual provides essential information for setting up, operating, maintaining, and troubleshooting your Inspire T10 speakers.

Key Features

- **Compact and Sleek Design:** High-glossy black finish, ideal for matching with PCs, notebooks, or MP3 players.
- **Premium 2.0 Speaker System:** Dedicated tweeter in each satellite for improved highs and mid-tones.
- **BasXPort Technology:** Provides strong bass without requiring a separate subwoofer.
- **Extended Listening Options:** Built-in headphone jack for private listening and an AUX In connector for external audio devices.

SETUP

1. Unpacking

Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Ensure the following items are present:

- Creative Inspire T10 Left Speaker
- Creative Inspire T10 Right Speaker (with controls)
- Power Adapter
- 3.5mm Stereo Audio Cable

2. Speaker Placement

For optimal sound quality, place the speakers on a flat, stable surface, equidistant from your listening position. Position them to form an equilateral triangle with your ears. Ensure there are no obstructions in front of the speakers.

3. Connecting the Speakers

1. Connect the audio cable from the left speaker to the corresponding port on the right speaker.
2. Connect the 3.5mm stereo audio cable from the "AUX IN" port on the right speaker to the audio output jack (headphone jack) of your computer, MP3 player, or other audio source.
3. Connect the power adapter to the power input port on the right speaker, then plug the adapter into a wall outlet.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Power On/Off and Volume Control

The main control knob on the right speaker functions as both the power switch and volume control.

- To power on, rotate the **POWER/VOLUME** knob clockwise until you hear a click and the power indicator light illuminates.
- Continue rotating clockwise to increase the volume.
- Rotate counter-clockwise to decrease the volume.
- To power off, rotate the **POWER/VOLUME** knob counter-clockwise until you hear a click and the power indicator light turns off.

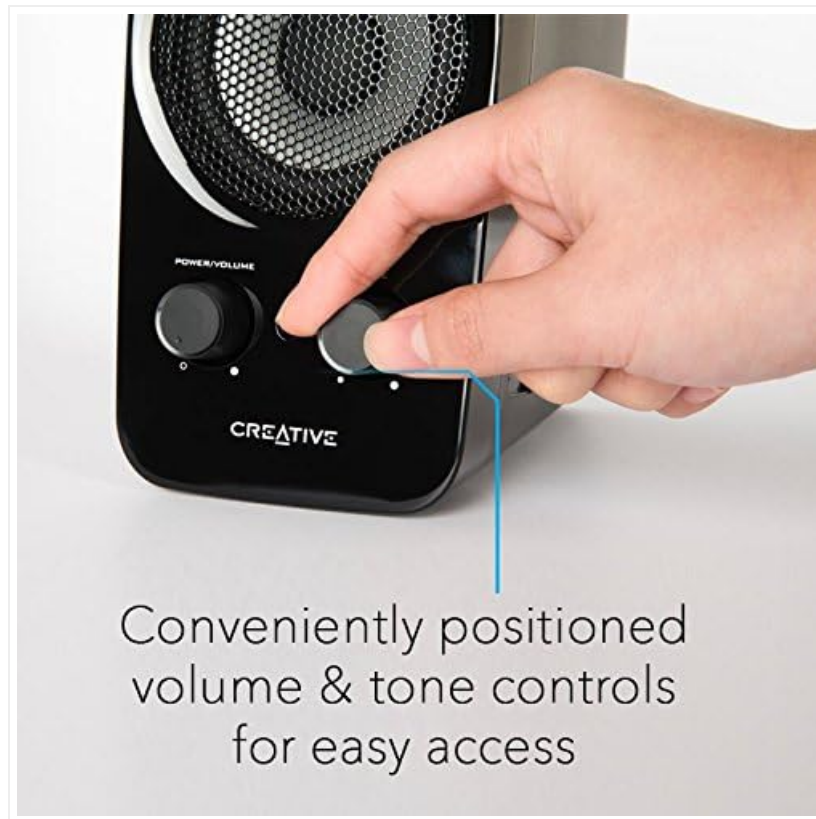


Image: A hand adjusting the conveniently positioned Power/Volume and Tone controls on the front of the Creative Inspire T10 speaker.

Tone Control

The **TONE** knob allows you to adjust the audio characteristics, balancing between bass and treble to suit your preference.

- Rotate the **TONE** knob clockwise to enhance higher frequencies (treble).
- Rotate counter-clockwise to emphasize lower frequencies (bass).

Using the Headphone Jack

For private listening, plug your headphones into the headphone jack located on the side of the right speaker. When headphones are connected, audio output from the speakers will automatically mute.

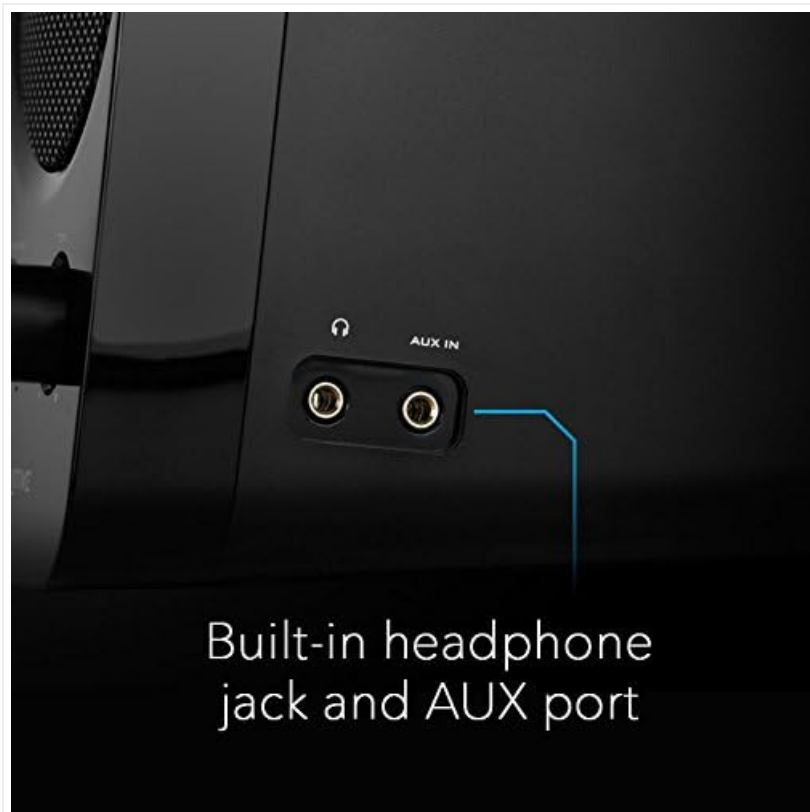


Image: A detailed view of the side panel of the Creative Inspire T10 speaker, highlighting the built-in headphone jack and AUX In port for external audio connections.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning

- Before cleaning, ensure the speakers are powered off and unplugged from the wall outlet.
- Wipe the speaker surfaces with a soft, dry, lint-free cloth.
- Do not use liquid cleaners, aerosols, or abrasive cleaning agents, as these may damage the finish or internal components.

Storage

When not in use for extended periods, store the speakers in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

Safety Precautions

- Do not expose the speakers to water or excessive moisture.
- Avoid placing speakers near heat sources or in direct sunlight.
- Do not attempt to open or service the speakers yourself. Refer all servicing to qualified personnel.
- Ensure proper ventilation around the speakers.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Creative Inspire T10 speakers, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No sound from speakers.	Speakers not powered on.	Ensure POWER/VOLUME knob is turned on.
	Volume too low.	Increase speaker volume.
	Audio cable not connected properly.	Check all audio cable connections (speaker to speaker, speaker to audio source).
	Headphones plugged in.	Unplug headphones.
	Audio source volume too low or muted.	Increase volume on your audio source (computer, MP3 player) and ensure it's not muted.
Distorted or unclear sound.	Volume set too high.	Reduce speaker volume.
	Tone setting incorrect.	Adjust the TONE knob.
	Poor audio source quality.	Try a different audio source or file to determine if the issue is with the source.
Humming or buzzing noise.	Ground loop interference.	Ensure all connections are secure. Try plugging the speakers into a different electrical outlet.
	Loose cable connection.	Ensure the audio cable is fully inserted and not damaged.

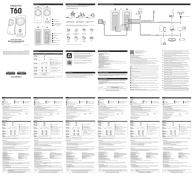
