# George Foreman GR0036W Fixed Plate Grill Instruction Manual

## 1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and care of your George Foreman GR0036W Fixed Plate Grill. Please read all instructions carefully before first use and retain for future reference.

## 2. IMPORTANT SAFEGUARDS

When using electrical appliances, basic safety precautions should always be followed, including the following:

- Read all instructions.
- Do not touch hot surfaces. Use handles or knobs.
- To protect against electrical shock, do not immerse cord, plugs, or appliance in water or other liquid.
- Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
- Unplug from outlet when not in use and before cleaning. Allow to cool before putting on or taking off parts.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug, or after the appliance malfunctions or has been damaged in any manner. Contact customer service for examination, repair, or adjustment.
- The use of accessory attachments not recommended by the appliance manufacturer may cause injuries.
- Do not use outdoors.
- Do not let cord hang over edge of table or counter, or touch hot surfaces.
- Do not place on or near a hot gas or electric burner, or in a heated oven.
- Extreme caution must be used when moving an appliance containing hot oil or other hot liquids.
- To disconnect, remove plug from wall outlet.
- Do not use appliance for other than intended use.

### **3. SETUP AND FIRST USE**

---

#### **1. Unpacking the Grill**

Carefully remove all packaging materials, stickers, and any plastic bands from the grill. Ensure all components are present: the grill unit and the dishwasher-safe grease tray.

#### **2. Initial Cleaning**

Before first use, wipe the grill plates with a damp cloth or sponge to remove any dust or manufacturing residues. Dry thoroughly. Place the grease tray underneath the front of the grill to collect any drips during cooking.

#### **3. Positioning the Grill**

Place the grill on a stable, heat-resistant surface, away from walls and cabinets, to allow for proper ventilation.

### **4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS**

---

#### **1. Preheating the Grill**

Plug the grill into a standard electrical outlet. The indicator light will illuminate, typically red, to show that the grill is heating. Once the grill reaches its optimal cooking temperature, the indicator light will change to green (or turn off, depending on the model). This usually takes a few minutes.

#### **2. Placing Food on the Grill**

Once preheated, carefully open the grill. Place your food (e.g., burgers, sandwiches, chicken) directly onto the bottom grill plate. For even cooking, ensure food items are of similar thickness. The floating hinge design allows the top plate to adjust to the thickness of your food, ensuring even contact and

cooking.

### 3. Cooking Process

Close the lid. The grill's angled design helps drain excess fat and grease into the removable drip tray positioned at the front. Cooking times will vary based on the type and thickness of the food. Refer to a cooking guide for specific recommendations. The indicator light may cycle on and off during cooking to maintain temperature.

### 4. Removing Cooked Food

Once food is cooked to your desired doneness, carefully open the lid. Use heat-resistant, non-metal utensils to remove food from the grill plates to avoid scratching the non-stick coating.

### 5. After Use

Unplug the grill from the outlet immediately after use. Allow the grill to cool completely before cleaning.

## 5. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

---

Proper cleaning and maintenance will extend the life of your George Foreman grill.

### 1. Cool Down

Always ensure the grill is unplugged and completely cool before attempting to clean it.

### 2. Cleaning Grill Plates

Wipe the non-stick grill plates with a damp, soft cloth or sponge. For stubborn residue, a small amount of mild dish soap can be used. Avoid abrasive cleaners, scouring pads, or metal utensils, as these can damage the non-stick coating. The instructions recommend using a paper towel to wipe off excess grease while the grill is still warm (but unplugged and safe to touch).

### 3. Cleaning the Grease Tray

The grease tray is dishwasher-safe. Empty any collected grease and wash it in the dishwasher or by hand with warm, soapy water.

### 4. Exterior Cleaning

Wipe the exterior of the grill with a damp cloth. Do not immerse the grill unit in water or any other liquid.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your grill.

- **Grill not heating:** Ensure the grill is properly plugged into a working electrical outlet. Check if the indicator light is on.
- **Food not cooking evenly:** Ensure food items are of uniform thickness. The floating hinge is designed to accommodate varying thicknesses, but extreme differences can affect even cooking.
- **Excessive smoke:** This can occur if there is a buildup of grease or food residue on the plates. Ensure the grill is thoroughly cleaned after each use.
- **Non-stick coating degradation:** Always use non-metal utensils to prevent scratching. Avoid

abrasive cleaners.





