5. SETUP & INSTALLATION

The Moen S112 Waterhill Rainshower Showerhead is designed for hassle-free installation. Follow these general steps:

1. **Prepare the Area:** Turn off the water supply to your shower. Remove any existing showerhead and clean the shower arm threads.
2. **Apply Thread Sealant:** Apply plumber's tape or thread sealant to the threads of the shower arm.
3. **Attach Showerhead:** Screw the Moen S112 Waterhill Rainshower Showerhead onto the shower arm. Hand-tighten first, then use a wrench to tighten an additional 1/4 to 1/2 turn. Do not overtighten.
4. **Test for Leaks:** Turn the water supply back on and check for any leaks around the connection. If leaks occur, tighten slightly more.

6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Moen S112 Waterhill Rainshower Showerhead provides a single, invigorating rain spray setting. Its Immersion technology channels water to deliver a perfectly balanced force and maximum coverage, creating a thorough rinse experience.

- **Turning On/Off:** Use your shower's main water control handle to turn the water flow on or off.
- **Temperature Adjustment:** Adjust the water temperature using your shower's hot/cold mixing valve.
- **Spray Pattern:** The S112 offers a single rain spray pattern, designed for a wide and gentle water delivery.

7. MAINTENANCE

To maintain the appearance and performance of your Moen S112 Waterhill Rainshower Showerhead, follow these cleaning guidelines:

- **Regular Cleaning:** Clean the showerhead regularly with a soft cloth and warm, soapy water.
- **Avoid Harsh Cleaners:** Do not use abrasive cleaners, harsh chemicals, or scouring pads, as these can damage the chrome finish and the rubber nozzles.
- **Mineral Deposit Removal:** If mineral deposits accumulate on the nozzles, gently rub them with your finger or a soft brush to dislodge the buildup. For stubborn deposits, a solution of equal parts white vinegar and water can be applied with a soft cloth, then rinsed thoroughly.
- **Drying:** After cleaning, wipe the showerhead dry with a soft cloth to prevent water spots.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your showerhead, try these common troubleshooting steps:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Low Water Pressure	Mineral buildup in nozzles or flow restrictor.	Clean nozzles as described in Maintenance. Check for and carefully remove any flow restrictor if permitted by local codes. Ensure main water supply is fully open.
Leaking at Connection	Loose connection or insufficient thread sealant.	Ensure the showerhead is tightened properly. Reapply plumber's tape or thread sealant if necessary.
Uneven Spray	Clogged nozzles.	Clean individual nozzles to remove mineral deposits.
