1. Introduction

The Reliable 700SB Portable Blindstitch Sewing Machine is engineered for home or small-business use, excelling in blind hemming applications for garments such as pants, skirts, dresses, and draperies. This machine features a true 1:1 to 2:1 skip-stitch function, allowing for seamless transitions between various fabric types. Its design prioritizes ease of use and consistent stitch quality across a range of materials.

2. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Always unplug the machine from the power outlet when not in use, before cleaning, or when performing maintenance.
- Keep fingers and loose clothing away from the needle and moving parts during operation.
- Ensure the machine is placed on a stable, level surface to prevent tipping.
- Do not operate the machine if the power cord is damaged. Contact qualified service personnel for repair.
- Avoid operating the machine in damp or wet conditions.
- Use only the specified needle system (29BL) and appropriate thread for your sewing tasks.
- · Keep out of reach of children.

4. SETUP

Follow these steps to set up your Reliable 700SB sewing machine:

- 1. **Placement:** Place the machine on a sturdy, level surface that can support its weight (approximately 6.35 kg). Ensure adequate space around the machine for comfortable operation.
- 2. **Power Connection:** Connect the variable-speed foot controller to the machine's designated port. Then, plug the machine's power cord into a suitable electrical outlet.
- 3. **Needle Installation:** Ensure the machine is unplugged. Loosen the needle clamp screw, insert a 29BL needle with the flat side facing the back, and tighten the screw securely.
- 4. **Thread Installation:** Follow the threading path indicated on the machine, ensuring the thread passes through all guides and the tension discs. Adjust the thread tension dial as needed for your specific fabric and thread type.
- 5. **Knee Lifter Attachment:** Attach the knee lifter to its designated slot on the machine. This allows for hands-free presser foot lifting during operation.
- 6. **Table Clamp Usage:** For added stability, use the included table clamp to secure the machine to your work surface.
- 7. **Initial Lubrication:** Before first use, apply a small amount of sewing machine oil to the designated lubrication points as indicated in the included oiling diagram (refer to the separate troubleshooting guide for details).

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Basic Operation

- Power On/Off: The machine is powered on when plugged in and the foot controller is engaged. Disconnect from power to turn off.
- Variable-Speed Foot Controller: Control the sewing speed by applying pressure to the foot controller. Start slowly and gradually increase speed as you become comfortable. The maximum sewing speed is 1725 rpm.
- **Knee-Activated Frame Drop:** Utilize the knee lifter to raise and lower the frame, allowing for simple insertion and removal of fabric without using your hands.
- Swing-Away Plate: For sewing flat pieces, such as drapery, the swing-away plate can be moved to provide a flat work surface.

5.2 Stitch Adjustment

- Skip-Stitch Function: The machine features a 1:1 to 2:1 true skip-stitch function. This allows you to select whether every stitch is formed (1:1) or every other stitch is skipped (2:1), which is useful for different fabric types and desired stitch invisibility.
- Stitch Penetration: Adjust the stitch penetration using the dedicated dial. This controls how deeply the needle penetrates the fabric, with a range of 0 to 7 mm stitch length. Proper adjustment is crucial for achieving an invisible blindstitch.

5.3 Fabric Handling

The 700SB is designed to handle a wide range of fabrics, from fine sheer materials to heavier woolens. When changing fabric types, it is often necessary to adjust the stitch penetration, thread tension, and potentially the needle size to achieve optimal results.

6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your sewing machine.

- Cleaning: Regularly remove lint and dust from the needle plate area, feed dogs, and bobbin case using a small brush or vacuum cleaner. Accumulation of lint can affect stitch quality and machine operation.
- **Lubrication:** The 700SB requires manual lubrication. Refer to the oiling points diagram in the separate troubleshooting guide. Apply a few drops of high-quality sewing machine oil to these points periodically, especially after extended use.
- **Needle Replacement:** Replace needles frequently, especially when working with new projects or if you notice skipped stitches or fabric damage. A dull or bent needle can cause significant issues.
- **General Care:** Keep the machine covered when not in use to protect it from dust. Avoid pulling on the fabric forcefully while sewing, as this can bend the needle or damage the machine's internal mechanisms.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter. For more detailed troubleshooting steps, refer to the dedicated troubleshooting guide included with your machine.

- **Skipped Stitches:** Check if the needle is inserted correctly and is not bent or dull. Ensure the correct needle size is used for the fabric. Verify proper threading and tension.
- Thread Breaking: Inspect the threading path for any snags or incorrect routing. Check thread tension; it might be too tight. Ensure the needle is not damaged and is the correct size. Use good quality thread.
- Fabric Not Feeding Properly: Ensure the feed dogs are engaged. Check for lint buildup under the needle plate. Verify that the presser foot is lowered.
- **Machine Not Starting:** Confirm the power cord is securely plugged in and the foot controller is connected. Check for any obstructions in the handwheel or needle area.
