## INTRODUCTION

## SETUP

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### 1. Unpacking

Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Ensure that the telephone base, handset, and coiled cord are present.

### 2. Connecting the Handset

Connect the coiled fabric cord to the handset and to the designated port on the telephone base. Ensure a secure connection at both ends.

### 3. Connecting to the Telephone Line

Plug the telephone line cord (not always included, use a standard RJ11 phone cable) into the telephone line port on the back or side of the telephone base. Then, plug the other end of the telephone line cord into your wall telephone jack.

### 4. Power Source

This telephone operates via the telephone line's electrical current and does not require external power adapters or batteries.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

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### 1. Making a Call

1. Lift the handset from the cradle.
2. Listen for a dial tone.
3. Place your finger in the hole corresponding to the first digit of the number you wish to dial.
4. Rotate the dial clockwise until your finger reaches the finger stop. Release the dial.
5. Repeat this process for each subsequent digit until the full number is dialed.
6. Wait for the call to connect.

### 2. Receiving a Call

1. When the telephone rings, lift the handset from the cradle.
2. Begin your conversation.

### 3. Ending a Call

To end a call, simply place the handset back onto the telephone cradle.

## MAINTENANCE

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### Cleaning

- To clean the telephone, use a soft, damp cloth.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners, solvents, or strong chemicals, as these can damage the finish.
- Ensure the telephone is disconnected from the wall jack before cleaning.

## General Care

- Avoid exposing the telephone to excessive moisture or extreme temperatures.
- Do not drop the telephone or subject it to strong impacts.
- Keep the telephone away from direct sunlight and heat sources.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No dial tone	Telephone line not connected or faulty.	Check all cable connections. Test with another phone if available. Contact your telephone service provider.
Cannot make calls	Incorrect dialing procedure or line issue.	Ensure you are dialing correctly using the rotary mechanism. Verify dial tone.
Cannot receive calls	Telephone line issue or ringer volume set too low (if applicable).	Check line connection. Ensure the ringer is not muted (if a switch is present).
Static or poor call quality	Loose connection or line interference.	Check all connections. Avoid placing the phone near other electronic devices that may cause interference.
