1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the proper installation, operation, and maintenance of your Four Seasons/Trumark 35059 Blower Motor with Wheel. Designed to meet or exceed original equipment (OE) specifications, this blower motor is a critical component of your vehicle's heating, ventilation, and air conditioning (HVAC) system. Adhering to these instructions will help ensure the longevity and optimal performance of the product.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

3. INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

The Four Seasons/Trumark 35059 Blower Motor with Wheel is designed for direct replacement in compatible vehicles. Professional installation is recommended. The following steps provide a general overview; specific procedures may vary by vehicle model.

1. **Preparation:** Park the vehicle on a level surface and engage the parking brake. Disconnect the negative terminal of the vehicle's battery.
2. **Access:** Locate the blower motor assembly, typically found under the dashboard on the passenger side. This may require removing trim panels, the glove box, or other components. Consult your vehicle's service manual for exact access procedures.
3. **Disconnect:** Disconnect the electrical connector from the existing blower motor. If present, also disconnect any ventilation hoses or tubes.

4. OPERATION

The Four Seasons/Trumark 35059 Blower Motor with Wheel operates in conjunction with your vehicle's HVAC control system. Once installed, its function is to draw air from the vehicle's exterior or interior, pass it through the heater core or evaporator, and then force it into the passenger cabin through the various vents. The speed of the blower motor is controlled by the fan speed selector on your vehicle's dashboard.

- **Fan Speed Control:** Adjust the fan speed selector on your vehicle's climate control panel to increase or decrease the airflow.
- **Mode Selection:** Use the mode selector to direct airflow to the desired vents (e.g., dashboard vents, floor vents, defrost vents).
- **Temperature Control:** The blower motor works with the temperature control to circulate heated or cooled air.

5. MAINTENANCE

While the Four Seasons/Trumark 35059 Blower Motor is designed for durability, regular maintenance of your vehicle's HVAC system can prolong its life and ensure efficient operation:

- **Cabin Air Filter:** Regularly inspect and replace your vehicle's cabin air filter according to the manufacturer's recommendations. A clogged filter can restrict airflow, causing the blower motor to work harder and potentially shorten its lifespan.
- **Debris Removal:** Periodically check the air intake area (often near the windshield cowl) for leaves, dirt, and other debris that could be drawn into the blower motor housing.
- **System Inspection:** Have your vehicle's entire HVAC system inspected during routine service to identify and address any issues that could impact the blower motor.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you experience issues with your blower motor, consider the following common troubleshooting steps:

Symptom	Possible Cause	Solution
Blower motor does not operate at any speed.	Blown fuse, faulty electrical connection, failed blower motor resistor, failed blower motor.	Check relevant fuses. Inspect electrical connections. Test blower motor resistor. If all else fails, the motor may need replacement.
Blower motor only works on high speed.	Failed blower motor resistor.	Replace the blower motor resistor.
Weak or reduced airflow.	Clogged cabin air filter, obstructions in air ducts, failing blower motor.	Inspect and replace cabin air filter. Check for and remove obstructions.
Unusual noise (squealing, grinding, rattling) from blower motor.	Debris in blower housing, worn motor bearings, unbalanced fan wheel.	Inspect for and remove debris. If noise persists, the motor may require replacement.

If troubleshooting does not resolve the issue, it is recommended to consult a qualified automotive technician.
