- 2. **Insert Gaskets:** Place one rubber gasket into each end of the shower hose. These gaskets are crucial for preventing leaks.

- 3. **Connect to Hand Shower:** Take the longer end of the hose and securely attach it to your handheld shower head. Hand-tighten until snug.
- 4. **Connect to Wall Outlet:** Attach the shorter end of the hose to the wall outlet (or shower arm diverter). Hand-tighten until snug.
- 5. **Test for Leaks:** Turn on the water supply and check for any leaks at both connection points. If leaks occur, gently tighten the connections further. Do not overtighten.

3.3. Break-in Period

When first unboxed, the hose may appear coiled. This is normal. To help the hose become more flexible and hang naturally:

- After installation, run hot water through the hose for a few minutes.
- Over the next month of regular use, the hose will gradually relax and hang more naturally.

. Leaks at Connections:

- Ensure the connections are hand-tightened securely.
- Verify that rubber gaskets are properly seated in both ends of the hose. If gaskets are missing or damaged, replace them.

• Hose Remains Coiled/Stiff:

 As mentioned in the "Break-in Period" section, new hoses may be stiff. Run hot water through the hose and allow it to relax with regular use over time.

· Reduced Water Flow:

- o Check your handheld shower head for mineral buildup or blockages.
- Ensure the hose is not kinked or obstructed.
