Scientific Atlanta Webstar DPC2100 Cable Modem User Manual

INTRODUCTION

The Scientific Atlanta Webstar DPC2100 is a high-speed cable modem designed to provide reliable internet connectivity. This device supports automatic software upgrades from your cable service provider and ensures interoperability by complying with Data Over Cable System Interface Specifications (DOCSIS). The DPC2100 offers plug-and-play operation for straightforward setup and includes both USB and Ethernet connections for versatile device connectivity.

PACKAGE CONTENTS

Before proceeding with the installation, please verify that your package contains the following items:

- Scientific Atlanta Webstar DPC2100 Cable Modem
- Power Adapter
- Ethernet Cable
- USB Cable

SETUP

Connecting the Modem

Follow these steps to connect your DPC2100 cable modem:

1. Connect one end of the coaxial cable to the cable wall outlet and the other end to the 'Cable In' port on the back of the DPC2100 modem.
2. Connect the Ethernet cable from the modem's Ethernet port to your computer's Ethernet port or to your router's WAN/Internet port. Alternatively, you can use a USB cable to connect the modem to your computer's USB port.
3. Connect the power adapter to the modem's power input and then plug the adapter into a standard electrical outlet.
4. Allow a few minutes for the modem to power on and establish a connection with your cable service provider. The indicator lights on the front panel will illuminate as the modem initializes.

Activating Your Service

After physically connecting the modem, you will need to contact your Internet Service Provider (ISP) to activate your internet service. Be prepared to provide them with the MAC address of your DPC2100 modem, which is typically located on a label on the bottom or back of the device.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Understanding LED Indicators

The DPC2100 cable modem features several LED indicators on its front panel to display its operational status. Refer to the table below for their meanings:

Indicator	Status	Description
Power	Solid Green	The modem is powered on.
Receive	Solid Green	The modem is receiving data from the cable network.
Send	Solid Green	The modem is sending data to the cable network.
Online	Solid Green	The modem is connected to the internet.
Link	Solid Green	An Ethernet or USB device is connected and active.

MAINTENANCE

General Maintenance

To ensure optimal performance and longevity of your DPC2100 cable modem, follow these guidelines:

- Keep the modem in a well-ventilated area to prevent overheating.
- Avoid placing the modem near sources of heat or moisture.
- Clean the exterior of the modem with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use liquid cleaners.
- Periodically check cable connections to ensure they are secure.
- If experiencing connectivity issues, try power cycling the modem by unplugging it for 30 seconds and then plugging it back in.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Common Issues and Solutions

- **No Power:**
Symptom: The Power LED is off.
Solution: Ensure the power adapter is securely connected to the modem and a working electrical outlet.
- **No Internet Connection:**
Symptom: The Online LED is off or blinking.
Solution:
 - a. Verify all cables (coaxial, Ethernet) are properly connected.
 - b. Power cycle the modem by unplugging it for 30 seconds and then plugging it back in.
 - c. Contact your Internet Service Provider (ISP) to confirm service status and modem activation.
- **Slow Internet Speed:**
Symptom: Internet connection is slower than expected.
Solution:
 - a. Ensure your service plan supports the speeds you expect.
 - b. Temporarily connect a computer directly to the modem via Ethernet to rule out router or Wi-Fi issues.
 - c. Contact your ISP for further diagnostics and to check for network issues in your area.
