1. Introduction

This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation of your Hotpoint-Ariston FQ 103 GP.1 ICE F/HA electric built-in oven. Please read these instructions carefully before using the appliance and keep them for future reference.

The Hotpoint-Ariston FQ 103 GP.1 is a 58-liter multi-function electric oven featuring pyrolytic self-cleaning, a cool-touch door, and 10 cooking modes, designed for seamless integration into your kitchen.

2. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Always adhere to the following safety guidelines to prevent injury or damage to the appliance:

- Ensure the oven is correctly installed by a qualified technician before use.
- · Do not allow children to operate or play with the oven.
- The oven becomes hot during operation. Avoid touching heating elements or interior surfaces. Use oven mitts.
- Do not store flammable materials in or near the oven.
- Always disconnect the appliance from the power supply before cleaning or maintenance.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners or sharp metal scrapers to clean the oven door glass, as they can scratch the surface, potentially leading to shattering.
- Ensure proper ventilation during and after cooking.

3. Installation

The Hotpoint-Ariston FQ 103 GP.1 is designed as a built-in appliance. Installation should only be performed by a qualified professional in accordance with local regulations and the provided installation template (not included in this manual). Ensure adequate clearance for ventilation and proper electrical connection.

Dimensions: The oven measures approximately 54.5 cm (depth) x 59.5 cm (width) x 59.5 cm (height). Refer to the installation guide for precise cutout dimensions.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Control Panel Overview

The oven features a digital display and touch controls for selecting functions, setting temperature, and managing timers. Familiarize yourself with the icons on the control panel.

4.2 Setting the Clock and Timer

- Setting the Clock: Upon initial power-up or after a power outage, the clock will flash. Use the appropriate buttons (refer to your specific model's control panel icons) to set the current time. Confirm the setting.
- **Using the Minute Minder:** The minute minder functions as a kitchen timer and does not control oven operation. Set the desired duration, and an audible signal will sound when the time expires.
- **Programming Cooking Duration:** For automatic cooking, select a cooking mode and temperature, then use the programmer function to set the desired cooking time. The oven will switch off automatically when the time elapses.

4.3 Cooking Modes

This oven offers **10 distinct cooking modes** to suit various culinary needs. Refer to the icons on your control panel to select the desired mode. Common modes include:

- Convection: Ideal for even cooking and baking on multiple levels.
- Grill: For browning, toasting, and grilling smaller items.
- Fan-assisted Grill: Combines grilling with fan circulation for faster, more even grilling.
- Bottom Heat: For dishes requiring more heat from the base.
- Defrost: Gentle thawing of frozen foods.
- · Consult your oven's specific icon guide for a full description of all 10 modes.

4.4 Using the Grill

To use the grill function, select the grill mode from the control panel. Place food on the grill rack, ensuring adequate distance from the heating element. Monitor food closely to prevent burning.

5. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

5.1 Pyrolytic Self-Cleaning

The pyrolytic cleaning cycle heats the oven to a very high temperature (approximately 500°C), incinerating food residues into a fine ash. This ash can then be easily wiped away once the oven has cooled.

- Remove all accessories (racks, trays, side supports) from the oven before starting a pyrolytic cycle.
- Wipe away any large spills or loose debris.
- Ensure the kitchen is well-ventilated during the cycle.
- The oven door will automatically lock during the pyrolytic cycle and remain locked until the temperature has dropped to a safe level.
- After the cycle, once the oven is cool, wipe the interior with a damp cloth to remove the ash.

5.2 Cool Door Feature

This oven is equipped with a cool door feature, maintaining the external door temperature at approximately 60°C during operation, enhancing safety, especially in households with children.

5.3 General Cleaning

- Clean the oven regularly to prevent food residue buildup.
- Use mild detergents and a soft cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners.
- Clean the exterior surfaces with a damp cloth and dry thoroughly.
- The glass door can be cleaned with a non-abrasive glass cleaner.

6. Troubleshooting

If you encounter issues with your oven, consult the following common troubleshooting tips before contacting service.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Oven does not heat	No power supply; incorrect settings; fuse tripped.	Check power connection; verify cooking mode and temperature settings; check household fuse box.
Food not cooking evenly	Incorrect rack position; oven overloaded; door not fully closed.	Adjust rack position; avoid overloading; ensure door is sealed.
Pyrolytic cycle not starting	Oven door not closed properly; accessories still inside.	Ensure door is fully closed and latched; remove all internal accessories.
Display shows an error code	Internal fault.	Note the error code and consult the Hotpoint-Ariston service center.

If the problem persists after attempting these solutions, contact qualified service personnel.




