## INTRODUCTION

The Belkin 200 Mbps Powerline 3-Port Adapter allows you to extend your home network using your existing electrical wiring. This kit provides a reliable, high-speed internet connection to areas where wireless signals may be weak or unavailable, supporting data transfer rates up to 200 Mbps. It is designed for simple plug-and-play installation, converting any electrical outlet into a network connection point.

## WHAT'S IN THE BOX

Upon opening your Belkin Powerline AV+ kit, you should find the following components:

- Two Powerline Networking Adapters (one single-port, one three-port)
- Two Ethernet cables
- Two power cords
- Two wall plug adapters
- Quick installation guide

## SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

Setting up your Belkin Powerline 3-Port Adapter is a straightforward, three-step process:

1. **Connect the Single-Port Adapter:** Plug the single-port Powerline adapter directly into a wall outlet near your internet router. Connect one end of an Ethernet cable to the adapter and the other end to an available LAN port on your router.
2. **Connect the Three-Port Adapter:** Plug the three-port Powerline adapter directly into a wall outlet in the room where you need network access. Ensure it is not plugged into a power strip or surge protector, as this can interfere with performance.
3. **Connect Your Devices:** Use Ethernet cables to connect your devices (such as computers, gaming consoles, or smart TVs) to the available ports on the three-port Powerline adapter. The network connection should establish automatically.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once both Powerline adapters are connected and powered, they automatically establish a secure network connection through your home's electrical wiring. This creates a stable and fast wired network link without the need for new Ethernet cabling.

The Powerline network is ideal for high-bandwidth activities and connecting devices that benefit from a stable wired connection:

- **Computers:** Connect desktop PCs or laptops for reliable internet access and file transfers.
- **Gaming Consoles:** Provides a low-latency connection for online gaming.
- **Smart TVs & Streaming Devices:** Ensures smooth streaming of high-definition video content.
- **Network Attached Storage (NAS):** Facilitates fast data access for backup and media serving.

## MAINTENANCE

---

To ensure optimal performance and longevity of your Powerline adapters, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Gently wipe the exterior of the adapters with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use liquid cleaners or aerosols.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure the adapters are placed in well-ventilated areas and their vents are not obstructed.
- **Direct Connection:** Always plug the adapters directly into a wall outlet. Avoid using power strips, extension cords, or surge protectors, as these can degrade performance.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

---

If you encounter issues with your Belkin Powerline adapters, consider the following troubleshooting steps:

- **No Network Connection:**

- Verify both adapters are plugged into live wall outlets and their power indicators are on.
- Check that Ethernet cables are securely connected to the adapters, router, and devices.
- Ensure both Powerline adapters are on the same electrical circuit within your home. Powerline technology works best when adapters are on the same circuit.

- **Slow or Intermittent Connection:**

- Avoid plugging adapters into power strips, surge protectors, or extension cords. These can filter the Powerline signal.
- Try plugging the adapters into different wall outlets to find the most efficient connection path.
- Large electrical appliances (e.g., refrigerators, washing machines) on the same circuit can cause interference. Try moving adapters away from such appliances.
- If connection drops occur, unplug and replug the adapters to reset the connection.

- **Adapter Lights Not On:**

- Check the wall outlet with another device to confirm it has power.
- Ensure the adapter is firmly seated in the outlet.
