SETUP

1. Initial Game Installation

1. Ensure your Nintendo Wii console is properly connected to your television and power supply.
2. Insert the Animal Crossing: City Folk game disc into the Wii console's disc slot.
3. Turn on the Wii console and select the Animal Crossing: City Folk channel from the Wii Menu.

2. Creating Your Character and Moving In

- Upon starting the game for the first time, you will be prompted to create your character and move into a new town.
- Follow the on-screen instructions to customize your character's appearance and choose your new home.
- Up to four household members can create characters and reside in the same town.

3. Nintendo Wi-Fi Connection Setup (Optional)

- To play with friends online, ensure your Wii console is connected to the internet via Nintendo Wi-Fi Connection. Refer to your Wii console's instruction manual for internet setup details.
- The game supports online play with up to three friends visiting your town.
- The optional Wii Speak microphone (sold separately) can be used for voice chat during online play.

4. DS Suitcase Mode

- The DS Suitcase feature allows you to transfer your character from your Wii console to a friend's Wii console for multiplayer sessions without an internet connection.
- You can also transfer your character from Animal Crossing: Wild World on Nintendo DS to Animal Crossing: City Folk.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Basic Gameplay and Controls

- Use the Wii Remote pointer to navigate menus, select items, interact with objects and characters, and move your character around the world.
- The game operates in real-time, meaning days and seasons progress as they do in the real world.
- Engage in various activities such as fishing, catching bugs, digging for fossils and buried treasure, and collecting items.

2. Interacting with Villagers and Environment

- Befriend your animal neighbors by exchanging letters, gifts, and favors.
- Customize your house with furniture, wallpaper, and carpets.
- Design clothing and patterns at the tailor's shop.
- Participate in seasonal events and holidays, such as Halloween trick-or-treating or Bunny Day egg hunts.

3. Visiting the City

- Take a bus to the urban city area for additional activities.
- In the city, you can visit Gracie's boutique for fashion items, catch a show at the theater, or change your hairstyle and get a Mii makeover at the salon.

4. Multiplayer Features

- **Local Multiplayer:** Up to four players from the same household can live and play in the same town on one Wii

console.

- **Online Multiplayer (Nintendo Wi-Fi Connection):** Invite up to three friends to visit your town or visit theirs. Communicate via text chat, emoticons, or voice chat using the Wii Speak microphone.
- **WiiConnect24:** Utilize WiiConnect24 to buy and sell items with friends through silent auctions, view other players' homes, or send letters between towns.

MAINTENANCE

1. Saving Game Progress

- The game automatically saves progress at certain points. Always ensure the game has finished saving before turning off your console to prevent data loss.
- Do not remove the game disc or power off the console during a save operation.

2. Disc and Console Care

- Handle the game disc by its edges to avoid fingerprints and scratches. Store the disc in its case when not in use.
- Keep your Wii console in a well-ventilated area, free from dust and direct sunlight.

3. Managing Town Environment (Grass Wear)

- Repeatedly walking or running over the same paths in your town can cause the grass to wear down, revealing dirt patches.
- To encourage grass regrowth, plant flowers and trees in worn areas and avoid excessive foot traffic. Grass regrowth is a gradual process.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Issue	Possible Cause	Solution
Game disc not loading or reading.	Disc is dirty or scratched; console disc drive issue.	Clean the disc with a soft, lint-free cloth. Ensure the disc is inserted correctly. If issues persist, try another game disc to check the console's drive.
Cannot connect to Nintendo Wi-Fi Connection.	Incorrect network settings; router issues; Nintendo Wi-Fi service unavailable.	Verify your Wii console's internet settings. Restart your router. Check Nintendo's official website for service status updates.
Wii Speak microphone not working.	Microphone not properly connected; software settings.	Ensure the Wii Speak microphone is securely plugged into the Wii console's USB port. Check in-game audio settings.
Excessive grass wear in town.	Frequent movement over the same areas.	Vary your walking paths. Plant flowers and trees in worn areas to encourage regrowth.
