INTRODUCTION

The Bose SoundDock Series II digital music system is designed to provide high-quality audio reproduction from your iPod or iPhone. This system combines award-winning acoustic design with sleek styling and user-friendly features, making it an ideal solution for at-home listening. It allows you to dock your compatible Apple device to play music and charge simultaneously, delivering a rich and clear sound experience.

WHAT'S IN THE BOX

Carefully unpack all components and ensure the following items are included:

- SoundDock Series II digital music system
- Power cord
- Power supply
- Remote control

SETUP

Follow these steps to set up your SoundDock Series II system:

1. **Placement:** Place the SoundDock system on a stable, flat surface. Ensure there is adequate ventilation around the unit.
2. **Connect Power:** Connect the power cord to the power supply, then plug the power supply into the DC POWER input on the back of the SoundDock system. Plug the other end of the power cord into a wall outlet.
3. **Dock Your Device:** Gently place your compatible iPod or iPhone onto the 30-pin docking connector located on the front of the SoundDock system. Ensure it is seated firmly.
4. **Compatibility Note:** For iPhone 5 and other iPod/iPhone models with an Apple Lightning connector, an Apple Lightning to 30-pin adapter (sold separately) is required.
5. **Auxiliary Input (Optional):** To connect an external audio source (e.g., portable DVD player, CD player, or other MP3 player), connect a 3.5mm audio cable (not included) from the audio output of your device to the AUDIO INPUT jack on the back of the SoundDock system.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Learn how to use your SoundDock Series II system for optimal performance:

Powering On/Off

- To turn the system on or off, press the **Power** button on the remote control.
- The system will automatically turn on when a docked iPod/iPhone begins playing.

Playing Music from Docked Device

- Once your iPod or iPhone is docked, it will begin charging.
- Use the remote control to play, pause, skip tracks, and navigate playlists on your docked device.

- Adjust the volume using the + and - buttons on the remote or the volume buttons on the SoundDock unit itself.

Using the Auxiliary Input

- If an external device is connected to the AUDIO INPUT jack, the SoundDock system will automatically switch to the auxiliary input when audio is detected from that source.
- To switch back to the docked device, stop playback on the auxiliary device or remove the audio cable.

MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your SoundDock Series II system, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the exterior surfaces of the system. Do not use liquid cleaners or sprays directly on the unit.
- **Dust:** Regularly dust the speaker grille and docking area to prevent accumulation that could affect sound quality or connections.
- **Avoid Liquids:** Keep the system away from water or excessive moisture.
- **Temperature:** Operate and store the system within recommended temperature ranges. Avoid extreme heat or cold.
- **Power Cord:** Periodically check the power cord for any signs of damage. If damaged, discontinue use and contact Bose customer support.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your SoundDock Series II system, refer to the following common solutions:

| No sound from system | System not powered on; Volume too low; Device not docked properly; Auxiliary input selected | Ensure power cord is securely connected and system is on. Increase volume. Re-dock device. Disconnect auxiliary cable if not in use. |
| Device not charging | Device not seated correctly; Power issue; Incompatible adapter | Ensure device is firmly seated on the 30-pin connector. Verify power connection. Use an official Apple Lightning to 30-pin adapter if required. |
| Remote control not working | Battery depleted; Obstruction; Remote out of range | Replace remote battery (1 CR2 battery required). Ensure no obstructions between remote and system. Operate remote within line of sight and reasonable range. |
| Distorted sound | Volume too high; Audio source issue; Interference | Reduce volume. Check audio source for distortion. Move system away from other electronic devices that may cause interference. |
