## SETUP

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### Playing with Your Die-Cast Model

- This Hot Wheels model is a 1:64 scale replica, primarily intended for collecting and display.
- For play, gently roll the car on smooth, flat surfaces. Avoid rough play or dropping the model, as this may cause damage to the die-cast metal and plastic parts.

- The wheels are designed to roll freely. Do not force movement if resistance is encountered.
- This product is suitable for ages 3 and up. Adult supervision is recommended for younger children to prevent small parts from being ingested.

## MAINTENANCE

### Cleaning and Care

- To clean the model, use a soft, dry cloth to gently wipe away dust and fingerprints.
- Avoid using harsh chemicals, abrasive cleaners, or excessive water, as these can damage the paint finish or plastic components.
- Store the model in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight to prevent fading and material degradation.
- Keep the model away from extreme temperatures and high humidity.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

### Common Issues

- **Wheels not rolling smoothly:** Check for any debris or foreign objects lodged in the axles. Gently remove them if present. Ensure the wheels are properly aligned.
- **Loose parts:** Due to the nature of die-cast models, small parts may occasionally become loose. If a part detaches, it can often be reattached with a small amount of model-safe adhesive.
- **Paint chips or scratches:** These are typically a result of impact or rough handling. While minor chips can sometimes be touched up with model paint, prevention through careful handling is recommended.
