1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Invicta Pro Diver Collection Automatic Watch Model 8926. This timepiece is designed for durability and precision, featuring a robust stainless steel construction and a reliable automatic movement. This manual provides essential information for the proper setup, operation, and maintenance of your watch to ensure its longevity and optimal performance.


2. PRODUCT FEATURES

- **Case:** 40mm diameter, 14mm thick stainless steel case with an exhibition case back.
- **Dial:** Black dial with luminous hands and hour markers for visibility in low light conditions.
- **Movement:** NH35A Japanese Automatic movement with 24 jewels, ensuring accurate timekeeping without the need for batteries.
- **Band:** Stainless steel band, 205mm length x 20mm width, adjustable by adding or removing links. Features a secure fold-over safety clasp.
- **Crystal:** Durable mineral crystal.
- **Crown:** Screw-down crown for enhanced water resistance.
- **Bezel:** Unidirectional stainless steel bezel with a black top ring, useful for tracking elapsed time.
- **Water Resistance:** 200 meters (660 feet), suitable for professional marine activity and surface water sports, including diving.

3. SETUP AND INITIAL OPERATION

3.1 Winding the Watch

Your Invicta 8926 is an automatic watch, meaning it is powered by the motion of your wrist. However, for initial setup or if the watch has stopped due to lack of wear, manual winding is recommended:

1. Unscrew the crown by turning it counter-clockwise until it springs free.
2. Gently turn the crown clockwise approximately 20-30 times. This will provide enough power reserve to start the watch.
3. Once wound, the second hand should begin to move.

3.2 Setting the Time and Date

To set the correct time and date:

1. Unscrew the crown (if not already) and pull it out to the first click position. This is typically for setting the date. Turn the crown clockwise or counter-clockwise to adjust the date. Avoid setting the date between 9 PM and 3 AM, as this can damage the movement.
2. Pull the crown out to the second click position. This is for setting the time. Turn the crown to move the hour and minute hands. To ensure accuracy, set the time a few minutes ahead and then push the crown back in when a time signal (e.g., from a radio or phone) reaches the desired time.
3. Once the time and date are set, push the crown back in and screw it down tightly clockwise until it is secure against the case. This is crucial for maintaining water resistance.

4. OPERATING THE BEZEL

The Invicta Pro Diver 8926 features a unidirectional rotating bezel, which is a useful tool for divers and for timing various activities.

1. To use the bezel, rotate it counter-clockwise to align the zero marker (triangle) with the minute hand.
2. As time passes, the minute hand will indicate the elapsed time against the bezel's scale.
3. The unidirectional design prevents accidental rotation in the clockwise direction, which could lead to an overestimation of elapsed time during a dive.

5. WATER RESISTANCE GUIDELINES

Your Invicta Pro Diver 8926 is water resistant to 200 meters (660 feet). This rating indicates its suitability for:

- Showering and bathing (ensure crown is fully screwed down).
- Swimming and snorkeling.
- Scuba diving (non-saturation diving).

Important: Always ensure the crown is fully screwed down before exposing the watch to water. Do not operate the crown or pushers (if present on other models) while the watch is submerged or wet, as this can compromise the water resistance.

6. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

To keep your Invicta watch in excellent condition:

- **Cleaning:** Regularly wipe the case and bracelet with a soft, damp cloth. For stainless steel, a mild soap solution can be used, followed by rinsing with clean water and drying thoroughly.
- **Avoid Chemicals:** Do not expose your watch to harsh chemicals, solvents, or detergents, as these can damage the seals, finish, and movement.
- **Temperature Extremes:** Avoid sudden temperature changes or extreme temperatures, which can affect the watch's accuracy and water resistance.
- **Magnetic Fields:** Keep your watch away from strong magnetic fields (e.g., speakers, refrigerators, certain electronic devices), as these can magnetize the movement and affect timekeeping accuracy.
- **Servicing:** Automatic watches benefit from periodic servicing (typically every 3-5 years) by a qualified watchmaker to ensure optimal performance and lubrication of the movement.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Invicta 8926, consider the following:

- **Watch has stopped or is running slow:** As an automatic watch, it requires motion to stay wound. Try manually winding the watch by unscrewing the crown and turning it clockwise 20-30 times. If the issue persists, it may require servicing.
- **Date changes at noon:** This indicates the AM/PM is incorrectly set. Advance the time by 12 hours.
- **Condensation under the crystal:** This suggests a breach in water resistance. Immediately take the watch to a qualified watchmaker for inspection and repair to prevent further damage to the movement.
- **Bezel is stiff or difficult to turn:** Rinse the bezel area with fresh water to remove any debris or salt buildup. If it remains stiff, professional cleaning may be required.
