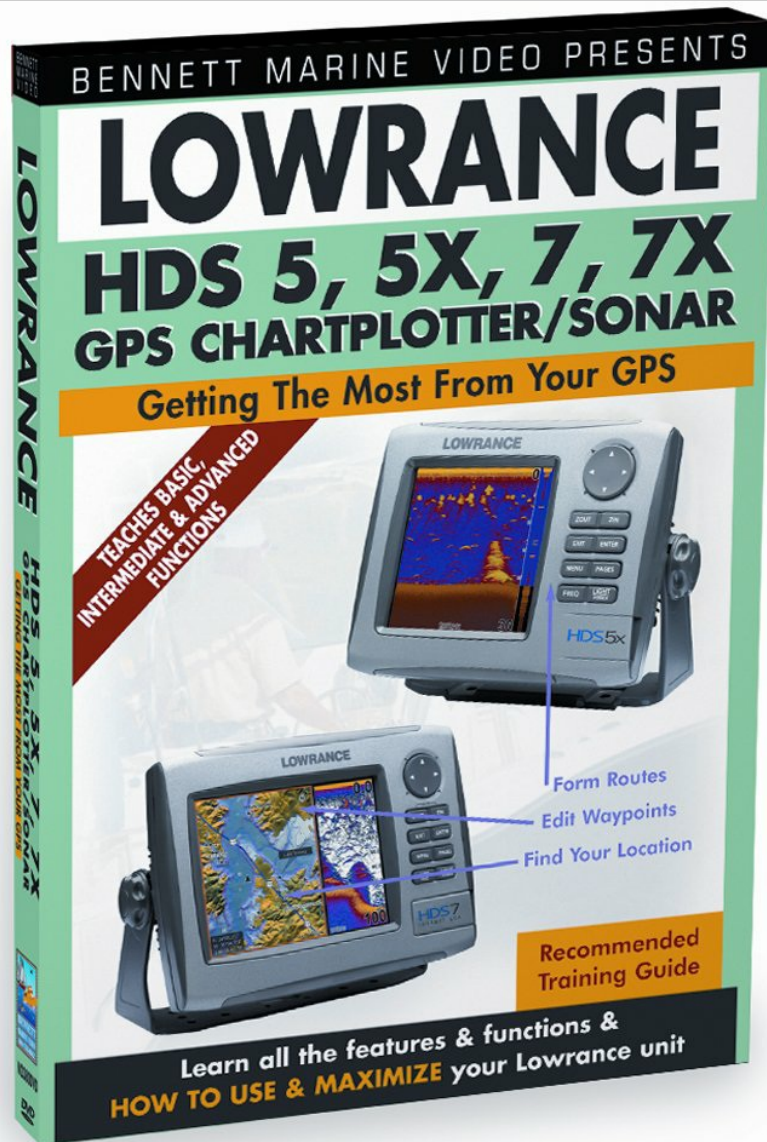


Figure 1: DVD cover for the Lowrance HDS Series Training Guide. The cover displays the title, supported Lowrance HDS models (5, 5X, 7, 7X GPS Chartplotter/Sonar), and images of the units. It highlights that the DVD teaches basic, intermediate, and advanced functions for getting the most from your GPS.

SETUP AND PLAYBACK

To begin using your Lowrance HDS Training DVD, follow these simple steps:

1. **Compatibility:** Ensure you have a standard DVD player, a computer with a DVD-ROM drive, or a compatible media player. The DVD is formatted for NTSC regions.
2. **Insert DVD:** Carefully insert the DVD into the disc tray of your chosen playback device.
3. **Automatic Playback:** Most devices will automatically start playing the DVD or display a main menu. If not, navigate to the DVD drive on your computer or select the DVD input on your player.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

- **Cleaning:** If the DVD becomes dirty, gently wipe the playing surface with a soft, lint-free cloth from the center outwards. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Storage:** Store the DVD in its original case, away from direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, and high humidity.
- **Scratches:** Avoid scratching the disc surface, as this can lead to playback errors.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues while playing the DVD, consider the following:

- **DVD Not Playing:**
 - Ensure the DVD is inserted correctly with the label side up.
 - Check if your DVD player or computer's DVD drive is functioning correctly with other discs.
 - Clean the DVD surface as described in the Maintenance section.
- **No Sound/Poor Video Quality:**
 - Verify that your playback device's audio/video cables are securely connected.
 - Adjust the volume on your TV/monitor or computer.
 - Ensure your display settings are appropriate for DVD playback.
- **Disc Errors/Freezing:**
 - Minor scratches or dirt can cause errors. Clean the disc.
 - Try playing the DVD on a different device to rule out player issues.
