1. INTRODUCTION

3. SETUP AND PREPARATION

4. OPERATING AND APPLICATION

Follow these general guidelines for applying the HP Permanent Gloss Adhesive Vinyl:

1. **Cutting:** Cut the vinyl to the desired size using a sharp utility knife or a vinyl cutter. Ensure clean, precise cuts.
2. **Positioning:** Carefully position the vinyl on the prepared surface. For large applications, consider using a hinge method or wet application method to prevent bubbles and wrinkles.
3. **Peeling Backing:** Slowly peel back a small section of the release liner from the vinyl, exposing the adhesive.
4. **Applying and Squeegeeing:** Starting from the exposed adhesive section, firmly press the vinyl onto the surface using a squeegee. Work from the center outwards, applying even pressure to remove air bubbles. Continue peeling the backing and squeegeeing until the entire graphic is applied.
5. **Finishing:** Trim any excess vinyl with a sharp knife. For optimal adhesion, allow the vinyl to cure for 24-48 hours, avoiding any stress or cleaning during this period.

5. MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and appearance of your applied HP Permanent Gloss Adhesive Vinyl, follow these maintenance tips:

- **Cleaning:** Clean the vinyl surface with a mild soap and water solution. Use a soft, non-abrasive cloth or sponge. Avoid harsh chemicals, abrasive cleaners, or stiff brushes, as these can damage the gloss finish and print.
- **Rinsing:** Rinse the surface thoroughly with clean water to remove any soap residue.
- **Drying:** Allow the vinyl to air dry or gently wipe it dry with a clean, soft cloth.
- **Avoid High Pressure:** Do not use high-pressure washers directly on the edges of the vinyl, as this can cause lifting.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Here are some common issues and their potential solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Bubbles or Wrinkles	Uneven application, trapped air, or surface contaminants.	Apply slowly with consistent squeegee pressure. For small bubbles, carefully prick with a needle and smooth. Ensure surface is clean.
Poor Adhesion	Dirty surface, low application temperature, or insufficient pressure during application.	Thoroughly clean and dry the surface. Apply in recommended temperature range. Use firm, even pressure with a squeegee.
Lifting Edges	Improper edge sealing, exposure to harsh cleaning, or extreme weather.	Ensure edges are firmly pressed down during application. Avoid direct high-pressure washing on edges. Re-apply if necessary.
