PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Arrow Fastener 50624SPTP 3/8" T50 Staples are high-quality fasteners designed for a wide range of stapling tasks. These genuine T50 staples are engineered for durability and reliable performance, ensuring secure fastening for various materials. COMPATIBILITY AND INSTALLATION

Arrow T50 staples are designed for universal fit with a variety of staple guns that accept T50 series staples. This includes Arrow T50, Stanley, DeWalt, and Bostitch staplers, among others. To install, ensure your staple gun is compatible with T50 staples of 3/8" (10mm) leg length. Open the staple gun's loading mechanism, insert the staple strip with the crown facing up, and close the mechanism securely. Always refer to your specific staple gun's manual for detailed loading instructions.

USAGE GUIDELINES

These 3/8" (10mm) T50 staples are best suited for applications involving plastic, house wrap, window screens, and roofing paper. For optimal results, ensure the material being fastened is appropriate for the staple length and your stapler's power. Apply firm, even pressure when operating the staple gun to ensure the staples penetrate fully and securely. Always wear appropriate safety gear, such as safety glasses, when using a staple gun.

CARE AND STORAGE

To maintain the quality and performance of your Arrow T50 staples, store them in a dry environment away from moisture and extreme temperatures. Proper storage prevents rust and corrosion, which can affect staple integrity and cause issues during use. Keep staples in their original packaging until ready for use to protect them from damage and contamination.

TROUBLESHOOTING COMMON ISSUES

- **Staples not feeding:** Ensure the staple strip is correctly loaded into the magazine, with the crown facing the correct direction. Check for any bent or damaged staples that might be obstructing the feed mechanism.
- **Staples bending or not penetrating:** Verify that the staple length is appropriate for the material being fastened. Harder materials may require shorter staples or a more powerful stapler. Ensure firm and consistent pressure is applied to the stapler.
- **Staples jamming:** This can be caused by incorrect staple size, damaged staples, or debris in the stapler's mechanism. Clear any obstructions and ensure you are using genuine T50 staples of the correct dimensions.
